General eligibility:-

- (a) He /She must be a citizen of India.
- (b) (i) He/ She must have passed the High School Certificate or an equivalent or any Higher Examination with Odia as a language subject or
(ii) He/ She must have Odia as a medium of examination in non-language subject at the High School Certificate or equivalent examination, which he/ she have passed.
- (c) Candidates having Bachelor Degree in Arts/Commerce/Science with Bachelor Degree in Education from any University of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities /institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational/ training qualification from concerned university/ institution form which they have obtained the degree .
- (d) Such outside University/institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their case will not be entertained.
- (e) He/ She must not have more than one spouse living.

1. Age:-

He/ She must be below 32 Yrs. and above 21 Yrs. of age as on 01.03.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 Years in case of candidates belong to the ST/SC/OBC/SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule, 1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years as per GA Deptt. Notification no.33068/Gen., dtd.27.10.1989 (Odisha Civil Service, fixation of Upper age limit Rules, 1989) and SEBC Act.

2. Educational Qualification:

- (a) **BA.BEd. Teacher** - He/she must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in Arts/ Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognised university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) alongwith a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised university.



- (b) **BSc.BEd. Teacher** - He/she must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in Science (CBZ/PCM) (with two school subjects) from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

(For the post of BA.BEd./BSc.BEd. the candidates must have to pass OSSTET conducted by BSE, Odisha within the prescribed timeline. Failure which, action will be taken as per Govt. Guide lines). Preference will be given to the OSSTET passed candidates.

- (c) **Sanskrit Teacher** – Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) with Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University/ Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University **OR** Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) from recognised University and Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University / Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (d) **Hindi Teacher**- Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti, Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June,2005, the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti , Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognised institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/ B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University/ BEd. in Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, a institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as one of the optional/ Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (e) **PET**- +2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/ PH/ OBC/ SEBC candidates) and CPed from recognised Board/University.
