Subject:- Prohibition on large gatherings or assemblies in wake of COVID 19- Advisory thereof.

ORDER

Whereas, the prevailing health situation (due to COVID-19) in several countries of the world has given rise to serious concerns in India as well; and

Whereas, COVID-19 has a pattern of transmission at a rapid rate in case prescribed preventive protocols, like social distancing and avoiding large gatherings are not strictly followed; and

Whereas, Government of India has declared Novel Coronavirus outbreak in the Country as "notified disaster" and advised immediate necessary preventive action thereof;

Now in view of the above, it is hereby ordered that :-

1. The public shall refrain from organizing or participating in any large gatherings or assembly at public places across the district.
2. All foreign returned citizens shall immediately report their arrival to District Control Room (01955253522 & 9419268121) for ensuring proper surveillance as per protocols issued by Ministry of Family Welfare Govt. of India.
3. District Information officer, Kupwara shall ensure circulation of this advisory among general public through Radio and Scroll on local cable network on daily basis.
4. Assistant Commissioner Revenue Kupwara & District Health Officer shall ensure wide publicity of Dos and Don'ts through announcements via 2 Mobile Vans engaged for the purpose, especially at all prominent public places within the district in both Urdu/ Kashmiri languages.
5. Executive officer of all three Municipalities shall ensure fumigation and sanitization of all Hospitals within their jurisdictions and vital installations including public offices, Bus/ Auto /Taxi stands, places of mass gatherings etc under the overall supervision of Addl Deputy Commissioner Kupwara.
6. Assistant Commissioner Development Kupwara shall ensure that there is no conduct of mass contact programmes including Gram Sabhas in all Panchayats till 31st March 2020 unless in cases of extreme exigency.

All Tehsildars shall ensure compliance of these instructions within their respective jurisdictions and report on daily basis to the District Control Room.
