Subject:- COVID-19 imposition of restriction under Sec.144 CrPC and
Section 34 of Disaster Management Act 2005 thereof.



ORDER

Whereas, restrictions were imposed under Section 144 Cr.PC on movement of Public and Transport throughout the District vide this office order No.36-DMK of Adm of 2020 Dated:-22-03-2020;

Whereas, the restrictions were modified and further extended vide this office Order No. 39-DMK of ADM 2020 Dated:-25-03-2020 for a period of 21 days i.e upto 14-04-2020 and subsequently extended upto 3rd May 2020 vide this office order No.40-DMK of ADM of 2020 Dated:-14-04-2020;

Whereas, Govt vide order No. 48-JK(DMRRR) of 2020 Dated:-03-05-2020, has categorized the entire Kashmir Province as Red Zone for the purposes of implementation of permitted activities as elaborated in the guidelines issued by Govt vide order No.49-JK(DMRRR) of 2020 Dated:-03-05-2020 to be effective from 4th May to 18th May 2020.

Now therefore in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 Cr.PC and Disaster Management Act, it is hereby ordered that:-

1. The restrictions on Public and Vehicular movement without valid permits issued by this office shall remain in force till 18th May 2020.
2. The movement of individuals for all non- essential activities between 7:00 Pm to 7:AM shall be completely prohibited
3. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women, and children below the age of 10 years shall stay at home , except for any medical exigency.
4. All shops in Municipal areas shall remain closed and only home delivery in these areas shall be allowed as per permits issued by AD Food Civil Supplies.
5. All Shops dealing with the essential commodities in Rural areas, including fruits, vegetables, groceries and dry fruits shall be permitted to operate from 9:00 PM to 7:00 PM to facilitate locals during the holy month of Ramzan.
6. Limited construction activities shall be allowed in the district except Red Zone areas as per directions in the specified format to be issued by the office of Chief Planning officer, Kupwara.
7. Labour intensive MNREGs works shall continue in the rural areas barring the red zone areas under the supervision of District Panchayat Officer Kupwara.
8. There shall be complete restrictions on entry/exit of persons /vehicles into / from the District without valid permit issued by the competent authority.

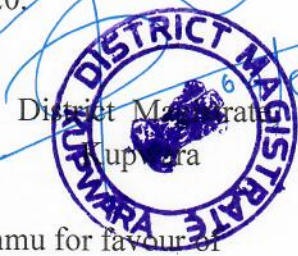
9. Any movement in or out of the Red Zones so notified shall be completely prohibited except with specific permission issued by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner Kupwara on the recommendations of Nodal officer designated for Red zones.
10. All activities permitted under the SOPs/ guidelines / instructions shall continue to be to be permitted in the District except in the areas identified as the Containment Zones and norms of social distancing and usage of masks shall be strictly adhered.

The instructions shall remain in force till 18/05/2020 or unless modified earlier.
