

OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, FARIDABAD
ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus (nCOVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC). Since Evidence of Local Transmission of the disease has been found in many countries including India and the infection typically spread from one person to another via respiratory droplets produced during coughing and sneezing, therefore, to mitigate the risk of nCOVID-19, contact/gathering of people in large number needs to be restricted.

Therefore, it is essential that gathering of 20 or more persons at public places should be prohibited and organizing social functions like Parties, Religious Functions, Dharna & Agitations, Jagrans/Jagratas etc. where a large number of peoples are likely to gather at a time should be restricted to prevent such danger to human health and safety in view of above novel Corona Virus (nCOVID-19) pandemic.

And whereas, I am satisfied that immediate measures are needs to be taken for prevention such danger of human health and safety relating to general public.

Now, therefore, as per the advisory issued by Home Department, Govt. of Haryana dated 20.03.2020 Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of CRPC, 1973, I, Yashpal, I.A.S. District Magistrate, Faridabad do hereby prohibit gathering of 20 or more persons at public places and also restrict organizing social functions like Parties, Religious Functions, Dharna & Agitations, Jagrans/jagratas etc. where more than 20 people are likely to gather at a time with immediate effect till further orders, whichever is earlier, in the jurisdiction of District Faridabad.

Adequate consideration may, however, be provided to movement of people in public transport (in Train, Buses etc.) or in any other mode of transport especially in the eventuality of medical emergencies.

Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, Commissioner, M.C. Faridabad, All Sub Divisional Magistrate's, Estate Officer, HSVP, Faridabad, District Higher Education Officer-cum-Principal Govt. Collage, Faridabad, District Education Officer/District Elementary Education Officer, Faridabad, Superintendent, Railways Faridabad and General Manger, Haryana Roadways, Faridabad shall be responsible for the compliance of the above orders.

In view of the emergent situation and shortage of time, this order is being passed ex-parte. If any person is found guilty, for violation of this order he shall be prosecuted and punished under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

District Information & Public Relations Officer, Faridabad shall give publicity of this order within the District Faridabad through print and electronic media.
