Subject: Implementation of Guidelines released for COVID-19 containment: procedure for providing permission to the public for gatherings

It is in reference to this office order No. DMC-SPO-2020/18314 dated 24.04.2021 in which at Sr. No. 2, social/ academic/sports/ entertainment /cultural/ religious/ political functions and other congregation have been restricted in the State. While releasing the guidelines, it has been directed that the organisers of social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political functions and other congregations shall take prior permission of District Magistrates. The District Magistrates or officers authorised by them will issue permissions after obtaining necessary NOCs from the Departments concerned including Police, MCs etc. Feedback has been received that applicants need to follow up their applications in multiple offices.

2. In this regard, you are requested to adopt a procedure for providing permission to the public as mentioned below:-

“Applicant may submit the application in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner concerned in any suitable form, i.e., either in Hard Copy or through email on official email ID provided by Deputy Commissioner. On the same day of receiving of application, O/o Deputy Commissioner will further send the soft copy of application through email to the Commissioner of Police/SP/DSP, SDM and Municipal Corporation/Council/Committee concerned for obtaining a No Objection Certificate on the same, If the office concerned doesn't have any objection, then they shall provide their NOC by 11:00 AM of the next day of receipt of application by email. In case, any office fails to provide the objection on the application by 11:00 AM, then the application will be deemed to have been cleared and permission shall be issued to the applicant without any delay.”

3. The procedure should be implemented with immediate effect in all the Districts of Haryana.
