**ORDERS**  
Bishnupur, the 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2021.

No.10/151/COVID-19/2021-DCB: Whereas, the Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority in exercise of the power conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 had issued Orders imposing "CURFEW" in the entire State for ten days by allowing only essential activities vide Order No.H-1601/6/2020-HD-HD-Part(1) dated 16/07/2021 and increasing the number of permitted activities vide Orders dated 19/07/2021 and 27/07/2021 while extending the curfew for another seven days from 28/07/2021 to 03/08/2021 hereby Orders extension of "CURFEW" for another four days i.e. upto 07/08/2021 vide Order of even number dated 03/08/2021.


- Whereas, positivity rate is still high in Bishnupur District.
- Whereas, there is an emergency and circumstances do not permit the serving of notice in due time upon the public, this order is passed ex-parte under Sub-Section 2 of Section 144 of Cr. P.C. 1973 and is directed to the public in general.
- Now, therefore, **I, Shri Krishna Kumar, IAS**, District Magistrate, Bishnupur District, Manipur in exercise of power conferred under **Sub-section 2 of Section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973**, hereby extends the order of even number dated 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021 issued in this regard for another four days i.e. upto 07/08/2021.
- The list of activities mentioned in the earlier Order of even number dated 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021, 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 and 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021 continues to be permitted (**Annexure-I**).

Only essential activities/services related to Vaccination, COVID testing, Medical services (hospitals, clinics/pharmacies), water supply, Power supply, Police, Telecom/Internet services, Air travel, Agriculture/Horticulture, Garbage, clearance, Petrol pumps, LPG distributors, Goods trucks and Print & Electronic Media.

**II. List of activities already permitted vide Order dated 20/07/2021.**

- i. Post Office with minimal staff for urgent Office work and delivery.
- ii. Veterinary and Animal Husbandry/Dairy – for collection and home delivery of milk and feeding of animals and birds in Government Farms.
- iii. E-Commerce delivery.
- iv. Banking and ATM services as per earlier Order i.e. (a) Banking services with limited staff on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10.00 a.m. to 2.30 p.m. for urgent Government and non-Government transaction only (b) ATM services including refilling of cash in ATMs.
- v. CAF & PD – minimum staff/personnel of CAF & PD and FCI.
- vi. Forest Department – continuation of tree plantations and also movement for feeding animals in the Zoo and National Park.
- vii. Officials and workers of road projects taken up by NHIDCL.
- viii. Officials and workers of road projects taken up by Asian Development Bank.
- ix. Officials and workers of Railway Projects in the State.

**III. List of activities already permitted vide Order dated 28/07/2021.**

- ii. Inclusion of vegetable/fish/meat and grocery items for home delivery in e-commerce allowed earlier.
