The references under section 47-A of Indian Stamp Act, 1899 are heard in the Court of Additional Deputy Commissioner (General), as Collector. There is a system in place whereby ADC(G) grants an opportunity of hearing to the Deptt and HRC presents Revenue side.

2. Sometimes, acting on the transfer applications, learned Commissioner orders hearing some of such 47-A cases by learned court of Deputy Commissioner. It has been gathered, that in the absence of any system for Revenue to plead their side; before the learned court of DC such cases could be decided in the absence of state version. The state going unheard in such cases, there was a likelihood of Revenue interest being jeopardised.

If approved, in the interest of Revenue, while hearing 47-A cases, the State may be put to notice which will ensure that State gets an opportunity to plead their point before the learned Court of Deputy Commissioner.
