

MINUTES OF THE REVIEW MEETING OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL COORDINATION COMMITTEE

VENUE : DC's conference room
DATE : 19.09.2016

The meeting was chaired by Smt. Harleen Kaur IAS, Deputy Commissioner Siaha. The Chairman welcomed those in attendance. The meeting commenced with a minute of silence observed for the sad and untimely demise of Pu PB Chhetri, DVO Siaha on 18.09.2016. The Chairman then apprised the member the agenda for the meeting. The following points which were discussed in the previous meeting were deliberated upon.

1. **Internet Connectivity:** In this regard, SDC (P) has been appointed as the nodal officer and he has taken relevant steps to address the issue of internet connectivity. As much as it has come to light, NIC is also taking necessary measures to strengthen internet speed and connectivity. The problem arises with BSNL and the matter is being taken up with their relevant authorities in Aizawl.

(Action : DC's OFFICE)

2. **District Playground:** The issue of revamping and construction of drainage system of the District Playground at Siaha Vaihpi shall be taken up by DRDA, subject to the availability of fund under MGNREGS.

(Action : DRDA)

3. **SSA Pipe band:** It was highlighted that Siaha is the only district in Mizoram without a pipe band in important days like Republic Day and Independence Day. For the establishment of a pipe band, State Project Director may be approached for procurement of necessary instruments and hiring of instructor. The matter will be addressed in the next meeting.

(Action : DPC SSA/ DEO MADC/ DPC RMSA)

4. **Road Protection and Side drain:** Encroachment of roads by the public comes under the purview of public nuisance. As a result, based on reports by the public or verification done by relevant authorities, relevant order under section 133 may be promulgated by DC's Office. Moreover, concerned departments of MADC, PWD and BDO are instructed to submit report on any incident of encroachment to DC so that necessary action can be taken.

(Action: Addl. DC, Sr RO Revenue Deptt. MADC/ EE PWD/ BDO Siaha)

5. **Maintenance of Siaha town roads by PWD Siaha Division:** In order to address the issue of maintenance of roads, the concerned department PWD shall write a letter to their authorities in Aizawl with a copy marked to DC Siaha so that action can be taken on these lines. The letter must be furnished by 26th September 2016.

(Action: PWD)

6. **School Contingents at Republic Day/ I-Day Parade:** It has been observed that students taking part in parade often pass out and faint. It was decided that a meeting to discuss the matter be convened only when such functions are around the corner. No immediate action seems necessary. However, DEO shall issue general instructions immediately to all schools regarding and particular instructions near such National Days.

(Action: DEO MADC)

7. **Legal Metrology:** To address the issue of the office being understaffed, the concerned department shall write a letter to their higher authorities in Aizawl, with a copy marked to DC Siaha so that action can be pursued at their end.

(Action: Legal Metrology)

8. **Issue of Stray Dogs within Siaha Town:** To curb the problem of dogs roaming the streets, appropriate orders may be promulgated by DC's Office. Moreover, a letter may be written to local NGOS and VCPs requesting for coordination in this regard.

(Action: Addl. Deputy Commissioner)

9. **Supply of Rice within Siaha District and the condition of roads thereof:** Timely supply of rice to villages is a problem due to bad condition of roads as well as insufficiency of stock. DCSO Siaha reported that they could not build up stock of rice as there was unavailability from State Government. DCSO shall take up the issue of stocking up of rice and other non perishable food items and ensure that they are received by beneficiaries. Also, PWD is to submit a list of all roads being undertaken by them to DC Siaha within 1 WEEK.

(Action: DCSO/ PWD)

10. **Public Transport:** It was highlighted in the previous meeting that it is quite difficult for candidates from Siaha to appear for exams/ interviews conducted in Aizawl due to poor public transport system. To address this issue, DTO may write a letter to Transport Department requesting for strengthening of public transport system, and request for more frequent services of Mizoram State Transport buses.

(Action: DTO Siaha)

11. **Problem of Street Lights within the town:** It was mentioned that absence of street light within the town harbours delinquents and trouble mongers at night making it unsafe for the public. SDO P&E mentioned that LAD MADC has been unable to pay for electric bills since last year as a result of which the street lamps are no longer functioning. P&E may write a report explaining the problem of non availability of power to DC Siaha. Furthermore, DC's office may explore the possibility of installing solar street lamps.

(Action : DC's Office)
