**NO.CON-3/PAP/65/10** :: In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 4 of the Bengal Eastern Frontier Regulation, 1873 and in partial modification of notification of even number dated 03/05/2018; the Governor of Nagaland is pleased to revise the validity period and the fee structure for issuance of Inner Line Permits for various categories and certain other conditions as under:

4	Labourer	100	3 months	Local Guarantor
5	Priest / Teacher	500	1 year	Local Guarantor
6	Student	100	3 months	Registration certificate from the concerned Institution situated in Nagaland for getting an ILP initially, and subsequently the Valid Identity Card issued by the concerned Institution shall be considered as <b>deemed Inner Line Permit (ILP)</b>

2. In addition to the existing mode of obtaining ILPs, the facility of online application and issue of online ILP for the category of applicants at serial 3, 4, 5 and 6 in the above para, will be made available from a date to be notified later.

5. This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.


