Subject :-Constitution of District Environment Committees for implementation of District Environment Plans.

Minutes

In pursuance of the Govt. Order No.81-JK(GAD) of 2019 Dated.25.11.2019 and review meeting held by the worthy Chief Secretary J&K through video conference ,5th meeting has been held under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner Budgam on 12.06.2020. The following officers were also present in the meeting:

- 1. General Manager DIC Budgam.
- 2. Assistant Commissioner Development Budgam.
- 3. Representative of Chief Medical Officer Budgam.
- 4. Chief Education Officer Budgam.
- 5. Representative from Chief Animal Husbandry Office Budgam.
- 6. Divisional Forest Officer Budgam.
- 7. District Panchayat Officer Budgam.
- 8. District Officer Pollution Control Board Budgam.
- 9. District Mineral Officer Budgam.
- 10. Executive Officers of all Municipal committees of the District.

At the outset the following directions/ instructions were passed and action taken by the above mentioned officers were also discussed:-

- 1. The Assistant Commissioner Development /District Panchayat Officer Budgam has submitted that DPR's of seven villages have been prepared and DPR's of two villages viz Sheikhpora and soibug stands approved and 20 lacs has also been released for the work, wherein the matter of Sheikhpora Budgam is subjudice before the Court of law and in case of soibug sight some shed type structure has been constructed on the identified sight by some person. It has been decided that Additional Deputy Commissioner Budgam and Assistant Commissioner Development Budgam will go to the sight on Tuesday and get the construction demolished. Moreover Assistant Commissioner Budgam is directed to prepare and forward all the 34 DPRs of 17 Blocks in one month.
- Chief Medical Officer Budgam submitted that due to unavailability of funds
 he is not able to install ETPs and it is decided that Chief Medical Officers will
 convey to Higher Authorities regarding the issue. Besides, District Officer
 Pollution Control Board and Chief Medical Officer Budgam will solve the

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issue. Chief Medical Officer is further directed to get all the blocks registered with Bio-medical waste disposing agency. Moreover, the Officer shall ensure the proper disposal of the biomedical and other wastes coming from the Quarantine and wellness centers.

3. General Manager DIC has submitted that the work on Common Effluent Treatment plant is going on and almost 65% is completed, and due to ongoing pandemic situation the work could not get completed within stipulated time. The officer is directed to push up the work on Common Effluent Plant and get it completed as soon as possible. Moreover District officer Pollution Control Board Budgam has submitted that some sewage is coming in marshy un notified wet land at Rangreth. As such the General Manager DIC Budgam is directed to get the issue resolved at an earliest.

4. Divisional Forest Office has submitted that he was having 60000 target of dibiling out of which he has completed 40000 .moreover he has delivered the plants of conifer and broad leaved plants to Chief Education Officer for schools and some Army Camps .The Officer is directed to deliver/issue 30000 plants of polycot/Conifer to Chief Education Officer Budgam. Chief Education Officer shall ensure the plantation through ZEOs by following the SOPs given for the ongoing Pandemic.

5. District Mineral Officer Budgam has been directed to issue notices to all Brick kilns to apply for the Environment Clearance. Moreover, a committee comprising of District Mineral Officer Budgam, Station House Officer Concerned, Executive Officer Municipal Committee Concerned and Tehsildar Concerned will be constituted to look after the illegal soil excavation in the District, who will penalize, prosecute and stop the violators from the illegal practice.

- 6. Chief Education Officer Budgam has submitted that Dustbins have been installed in all the Hr. Secondary's, High Schools, wherein there are no funds available for installation of dustbins in the rest of the schools. Chief Education Officer Budgam is directed to take up the matter with Assistant Commissioner Development and Chief Planning Officer Budgam, who will make the required funds available to Chief Education Officer Budgam through conversion.
- District Officer Pollution control Board Budgam is directed to check the source of informal trading /dismantling and recycling with Executive officers of Municipal Committees and to report in ten days.
- 8. Executive Officers have submitted that some institutions / offices are violating the guidelines of the solid waste management, while as they are directed to penalize the violators and to take action against them as warranted under law against them. Moreover a committee will be constituted comprising of Addl. Deputy Commissioner Budgam, District Officer Pollution Control Board Budgam, Assistant Commissioner Development Budgam and Executive

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Officers of all Municipal Committees, who will look after and ensure the proper disposal of garbage ,wastes etc within the resources of the District.

 Chief Animal Husbandry officer submitted that they don't have suffcent funds for management of biomedical wastes. The representative of the Office is directed to intimate the higher authorities about the same.

The above officers are being strictly instructed to submit the compliance/action taken report into the matterat an earliest. The another meeting (i.e 6th meeting) will be held on 3rd July at 11:30 am 2020. The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
