**Subject :-Constitution of District Environment Committees for  
implementation of District Environment Plans.**

**Minutes**

In pursuance of the Govt. Order No.81-JK(GAD) of 2019 Dated.25.11.2019 and review meeting held by the worthy Chief Secretary J&K through video conference ,6th meeting has been held under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner Budgam on 20.07.2020 . The following officers were also present in the meeting:

1. Representative of General Manager DIC Budgam.
2. Assistant Commissioner Development Budgam.
3. Representative of Chief Medical Officer Budgam.
4. Chief Education Officer Budgam.
5. Representative from Chief Animal Husbandry Office Budgam.
6. Divisional Forest Officer Budgam.
7. District Panchayat Officer Budgam.
8. District Mineral Officer Budgam.
9. Executive Officers of all Municipal committees of the District.

At the outset the the following directions/ instructions were passed and action taken by the above mentioned officers were also discussed:-

1. The Assistant Commissioner Development /District Panchayat Officer Budgam has submitted that DPR's of 18 blocks out of 34 blocks have been prepared. She further submitted that the illegal encroachment on the identified site stands removed wherein legal action against the encroachers has been initiated on spot under the supervision of Assistant Commissioner Revenue Budgam . The Assistant Commissioner Development Budgam is directed to withheld the salary of 11 AEEs of her office in order to make sure that the DPRs of pending Blocks be got submitted within ten days positively.
2. Chief Medical Officer Budgam submitted that due to unavailability of funds he is not able to install ETPs and it is decided that Chief Medical Officers will prepare and submit the DPRs as required to the Directorate Health Services Kashmir before next meeting. Besides, Chief Medical Officer Budgam will submit the detailed report with proof that he has applied for the consent / authorization before District Pollution Control Board by today evening .The officer is further direct to mention the reason of rejection of the cases, if any , by the District Pollution Control Board.

3. Representative of the office of General Manager DIC has submitted that the work on Common Effluent Treatment plant is going on and almost 80% is completed ,and due to ongoing pandemic situation the work could not get completed within stipulated time . The officer is directed to push up the work on Common Effluent Plant and get it completed as soon as possible. The office is further directed to submit the action taken report with regard to sewage coming in marshy un notified wet land at Rangreth by today evening positively .
4. Divisional Forest Office has submitted that the plants as directed to be handed over to Chief Education Officer are ready to be lifted, but the sapling in the current temperature and weather is not possible. As such it is directed that Chief Education Officer Budgam shall keep ready the pits as required for the plants so that the sapling will be done soon after the rainfall.
5. District Mineral Officer Budgam has submitted that in order to stop the illegal extraction of soil, bajri, boulders and sand, as was directed in the last meeting ,32 seizures were conducted by the undersigned during the month of june 2020 comprising of 10 JCBs,21 Tippers and 1 Tractor and an amount of Rs 549,515 were realized as compounding of offence from the offenders. Besides he with assistance of Tehsildar disrupted ramps approaching to the Nallas at village Dardpora and Dedina. The officer is directed to keep the continuous vigil and conduct the same practice in the unattended areas throughout the District in order to make sure that no illegal extraction is going on. Besides, he is directed to close all the un licensed Brick Kilns forthwith and in case he requires the assistance of Tehsildars ,he will be at liberty to do so. The report into the matter shall be submitted before next meeting.
6. Chief Education Officer Budgam has submitted that Dustbins have been installed in all the Hr. Secondary's , High Schools, wherein there are no funds available for installation of dustbins in the rest of the schools. The matter has been taken up with the Assistant Commissioner Development and Chief Planning Officer Budgam , who will make the required funds available to Chief Education Officer Budgam through conversion.
7. District Officer Pollution control Board Budgam is directed to check the source of informal trading /dismantling and recycling with Executive officers of Municipal Committees and to report in ten days.
8. Executive Officers Municipal Committees Budgam,Khansahib,Chadoora and Beerwah have submitted that the institutions / offices who are violating the guidelines of the solid waste management, are being warning/intimated to desist from such practice, however the report from Muncipal Committee Magam and Chraresharief is still awaited .As such the Executive Officers opf MC Magam and Chraresharief are directed to submit the compliance report by today positively. Moreover all the Executive Officers of Muncipal Committees of the District are directed to keep the continuous vigil on such institutions/ office and penalize them under rules if any violation is found.



As per the report submitted by the Committee Constituted under the supervision of Addl. Deputy Commissioner Budgam for checking the resources available in the District for management of solid waste, it is observed that some Municipal Committees have not the sufficient space available, specifically Municipal Committee Magam. As such the Executive officers of the Municipal Committees including Magam are directed to identify the places for the management of solid wastes and other wastes within the limits of their jurisdiction. The action taken report into the matter shall reach to this office before next meeting.

9. Representative of Chief Animal Husbandry office submitted that they don't have sufficient funds for management of biomedical wastes wherein they have taken up the matter with the higher Authorities many times but did not get any response. As such The representative of the Office is directed to submit the report into the matter by tomorrow, so that requisition shall also go from this office in order to get the issue resolved at an earliest. He is further directed to arrange the staff for lifting/ collection of the Bio medical wastes and to check resources within the District for dumping of the same.

The above officers are being strictly instructed to submit the compliance/action taken report into the matter before next meeting. The another meeting( i.e 7th meeting) will be held on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020 at 11:30 am .
