

District Highlights – 2011 Census

- Jamtara ranks 19th in terms of population (7,91,042) and 21st in terms of area (1811sq.km.) in the state of Jharkhand.
- In terms of population per sq.km. Jamtara is the 13th densely populated district in the state with 437 persons per sq.km as against the state's 414.
- Jamtara ranks 10th in terms of sex-ratio (954) against the state's 949.
- There are 79 uninhabited villages (out of 1,161 total villages) in the district of Jamtara.
- Chengaidi (under Jamtara C.D. Block) is the most populated village (5,754) and Sikandarpur (under Kundhit C.D. Block) is the least populated village (01) in the district.
- The economy of the district mainly depends on cultivation or related work. More than 64% of the total workers are engaged in Primary sector.
- C.D. Block Narayanpur has the highest number of villages (262) in the district and C.D. Block Jamtara has the lowest number of villages (137).
- Sudra Kshipur (under Kundhit C.D. Block) has the largest area (1109.69 hectare) and Sarodabarchak (under Karma Tanr Vidyasagar C.D. Block) has the smallest area (1.56 hectare) among the villages in the district.
- 25.65% and 64.67 % of Households of main source of drinking water are from uncovered- well and handpump respectively of the villages.
