

Guidelines of Notification No. 1319/2021, Dt. 24.09.2021.

I. Education qualification:

The Qualification prescribed for the post of Medical Officer, Pharmacist Gr-II, and Lab-Technician Gr-II is as follow:

Post	Qualification
Medical Officer	1.MBBS degree or an equivalent qualification as entered in the Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 as subsequently amended; 2. Registered with AP/TS Medical Council.
Pharmacist Gr-II	A) Intermediate B) Diploma in Pharmacy or Bachelor of Pharmacy C) Registered with Pharmacy Council T.S
Lab-Technician Gr-II	A) Intermediate B) i. DMLT or B.Sc. (MLT) from recognized institutions. (Or) ii. Intermediate MLT (Vocational certificate with One-year clinical training from any Dist. Hospitals / OGH/GH etc. C) Must be registered with the T.S. Paramedical Board

II. Selections criteria for Medical Officer:

Recruitment shall be done by the District Selection Committee.

Total Marks are 100 of which 90 marks will be allotted basing on the marks obtained in qualifying examination i.e, Final MBBS (Part -I and Part II) and 10 marks against waiting @ 1 mark for each year of waiting after completing MBBS course subject to maximum of 10 marks.

III. Method of Recruitment for Pharmacist Gr. II and Lab. Technician Gr. II

Recruitment shall be done by the District Selection.

Selections will be done based on the following criteria:

- (i) Total marks are 100 of which 90 marks will be allotted basing on the marks obtained in qualifying examination and 10 marks will be awarded for the age. Weight-age for age will be reckoned from 18 years of age of the candidate. 0.5 mark will be awarded for one completed year of age with a maximum of 10 marks. The age will be reckoned as on 01-07-2021. (Example 1. If a candidate completes 20 years as on 01-07-2021, he/she will be awarded 1.0 mark; Example 2. If a candidate completes 30 years of age as on 01-07-2021, he/she will be awarded 6.0 marks)
- (ii) Provisional list and Merit list will be prepared based on the marks criteria and displayed on Official website of transparency and also for calling objections.
- (iii) Selections list will be prepared from the finalized merit list duly following the Rule of Reservation (ROR) and Presidential Orders.

IV. Age:

The minimum age is 18 years and the maximum age is 34 years.

The minimum and maximum age shall be reckoned as on 01.07.2021 with the following reservation allowed for reckoning the maximum age limit as per rules in force:

For S.Cs. S.Ts& BCs 5 (five) years

For ex-service men 3 (three) years in addition to the length of service in armed forces

For Disabled persons 10 (ten) years

V. Rule of Reservations (ROR):

(i) Rule of Reservations in respect of Community, Disability, Ex-Service Men/Women shall be strictly observed as ordered by the Government of Telangana from time to time.

(ii) The Rule of Reservations to local candidates is applicable as per the Presidential order (New District Nirmal as per Circular Memo No.

3112/SPF.I/2021, Dated.22.7.2021 of General Admn, (SPF.I) Dept. Govt. of T.S)

(iii) The districts should continue the existing Roster.

VI. How to Apply

(i) Application forms along with instructions can be downloaded from the dist official web site of the Nirmal District.

(ii) Filled in application form shall be submitted in person or through registered post to the District Medical & Health Office, Nirmal to which the candidate is applying. Applications which are received after due dates will be summarily rejected. District Selection Committee is not responsible for post delays.

(iii) Self-attested copies of the following Certificates should be enclosed along with the application form:

1	S.S.C or Equivalent examination.
2	Intermediate or 10 + 2 examination.
3	Qualifying Examination Pass Certificate.
4	Marks Memos of all the years (qualifying examination)
5	Registration Certificates of respective Councils
6	Latest Caste Certificate issued by the Tahsildhar/MRO concerned
7	Study certificate for the years from 1 th class to 10 th class and in Case of Private study residence certificate from the Tahsildhar/MRO concerned.
8	PH certificate in respect of candidates claiming reservation under PH Quota.
9	Relevant certificates in respect of candidates claiming Ex-service Men Quota.
10	Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) eligible candidates should submit certificate issued by Tahasildar
11	(1) Photograph duly pasted on the application form.
