I would like to sincerely thank you and congratulate you for the keen interest taken in the implementation of Gram Swaraj Abhiyan. The programmes for social harmony, enrolment of beneficiaries, public information and saturation of seven programmes has been going on very effectively on account of the clear directions at your level. The nodal officers from the Central Government have also reported the support extended to them at State and District levels. Since many programmes involved Central Government agencies, the Abhiyan provided a platform for mutual cooperation between States and the Central Government.

2. While sincere efforts have been made for saturation of many villages out of 16,850 villages that were taken up during the campaign (minus West Bengal and Karnataka on account of Election Code of Conduct), in many others we need to continue the Mission mode thrust till we are able to fully saturate the villages. This is to urge you to instruct the concerned Departments and District Magistrates for an extended Mission so that we are able to achieve the outcomes of Gram Swaraj Abhiyan.

In villages which have already achieved saturation or will achieve over the next few days, I would like to request you to instruct the Panchayat Department to organize special Gram Sabhas in the concerned villages to celebrate the success achieved. This will not only foster social harmony but will also act as encouragement to adjoining villages which may like to participate in similar Mission mode efforts in the future.

4. To ensure that saturation truly happens to the satisfaction of every villager, we are providing for uploading of photographs of such special Gram Sabha meetings. A format regarding the seven programmes covered for saturation is also enclosed which may be got filled up by the Gram Panchayats and uploaded on the GSA portal.
