As per the paper read above, vehicles have been requisitioned and allotted to the Executive Magistrates of Flying Squads constituted for each LA Segment in Thrissur District, in connection with the General Elections – 2019.

Vehicle No. KL 08 AS 9316, attached to the Registrar, Kerala Agriculture University, Thrissur has been requisitioned and allotted to the Squad No. 3 of 067- Thrissur LAC. This vehicle is not suitable for the conveyance of the Squad.

- 01: The above custodian officer is directed to release the vehicle, with driver, immediately on receipt of this order and directed to report before the concerned Electoral Registration Officer.
- 02: The Electoral Registration Officer & Tahsildar will receive the vehicle with documents and hand over to the Executive Magistrates. The ERO should report the initial reading of the vehicle and the details as insisted in the guidelines of Election Commission of India.
03. The fuel charges of the vehicle, TA/DA admissible to the Drivers will be met by the ERO and keep separate account for that.
04. The Executive Magistrates will be in charge of the vehicle allotted. They will maintain the Log Book and other documents and ensure that the vehicle is used in their own jurisdiction, for the official duties, and as per the guidelines issued by the Election Commission of India/ Government. The documents of the vehicle should be submitted to the undersigned for verification, on demand.
