Sub: General Election to Loksabha 2019 – Cashless Treatment Scheme for polling officials on duty – Cashless Treatment Scheme – delegation of authority – Nodal Officer posted – Orders issued – reg -

ORDER No.EL1 – 140031/2019; DATED 19th MARCH 2019

In connection with the General Election to Loksabha 2019, considering time bound assignments of officials in unfamiliar surroundings and deployment of large number of manpower, Chief Electoral Officer has instructed to ensure welfare of all officials involved in the election process for smooth and successful conduct of election. Considering the aspects of welfare of Officials, Chief Electoral Officer has instructed to rollout a system of cashless treatment in medical exigency such as cardiac arrest, stroke, accident etc., for polling personnel while on duty in the state, in a way to provide immediate medical assistance on cashless basis in the nearest Government or Private hospital. The expenses met by the polling officials will be reimbursed by the District Election Officer.

The District Election Officer is authorized to draw & disburse the expenses incurred upto Rs.50,000/- and in the case beyond Rs.50,000/- but below Rs.1,00,000/- can be disbursed by District Election Officer subject to ratification by the Chief Electoral Officer. Expenses beyond Rs.1,00,000/- per person can be disbursed only after getting the approval of Chief Electoral Officer.

Vide read above Chief Electoral Officer has informed that a person is considered to be on election duty as soon as he/she leaves his/her residence/office to report for any election related duty including training and until he/she reaches back his/her residence/office after performance of his/her election related duty.

In this circumstance, Dr.Reena.K.J. (Mob.No.9946105485), District Medical Officer (Health), Thrissur is designated as Nodal Officer for Cashless treatment of polling personnel in Thrissur District with immediate effect.

If any unfortunate event or medical exigency such as accident, cardiac arrest, stroke etc., occurs to any election related officials on duty during electioneering, the responsible officer shall immediately make necessary arrangements of medical assistance to the bereaved on cashless basis in the nearest Government / Private hospital. The expenses in this regard will be reimbursed by the District Election Officer under the Head of Account "2015-00-105-99-34-OC".
