ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above marriage assistance of Rs.5000/- was provided for the persons who are marrying visually handicapped person. In the Government Order second read above the existing marriage assistance was then enhanced to Rs.25,000/- for persons who are marrying differently abled persons. Further, in the Government Order third read above, the marriage assistance was extended for persons who are marrying differently abled persons who are Non Graduates and Non Diploma Holders at Rs.25,000/- and 4 gms of gold (22 carat) for making Thirumangalyam.

2. In the Government Order fourth read above the marriage assistance was enhanced to Rs.50,000/- and 4 gms of gold coin (22 carat) for making Thirumangalyam for the persons who are marrying differently abled persons and who are Graduate / Diploma Holders. Further, in the Government Order fifth read above, the quantum of gold coin was then increased from 4 grams to 8 grams for persons who are marrying differently abled persons for all Marriage Assistance Schemes. The following four

Marriage Assistance Schemes are implemented to encourage the able bodied persons to marry a differently abled person:

Sl. No	Name of the Scheme
1.	Assistance to Normal person marrying Visually Impaired
2.	Assistance to Normal person marrying Orthopedically Handicapped
3.	Assistance to Normal person marrying Speech and Hearing Impaired
4.	Assistance to Differently Abled person marrying Differently Abled

3. The State Commissioner for the Differently Abled in his letter fourth read above had stated that the Marriage Assistance Scheme for Differently Abled Persons implemented by this department applies only to Non-disabled person marrying (i) visually impaired (ii) orthopedically handicapped (iii) speech and hearing impaired and for (iv) differently abled marrying another differently abled persons. He had further stated that the above scheme did not cover a non-disabled person marrying person with other categories of disabilities as in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and requested to extend the marriage assistance scheme to a Non-disabled person marrying any category of disabled person listed in the Right of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner for the Welfare of Differently Abled decided to extend the Marriage Assistance Scheme to a non-disabled person, / disabled person marrying person with any category of the following disability specified under Section 2(zc) of the Right of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 (Central Act 49 of 2016).

iv.	Dwarfism
v.	Muscular Dystrophy
vi.	Acid Attack Victims
vii.	Blindness
viii.	Low-vision
ix.	Deaf

xii.	Intellectual Disability
xiii.	Specific Learning Disability
xiv.	Autism Spectrum Disorder
xv.	Mental Illness
