

**Order Dated:- 09-07-2018** passed by Deputy Commissioner Ambala.

In pursuance of the instruction contained in the Punjab Government F.D letter no.7004-E-41/ 60571 dated 21-11-1941 & Haryana Govt. Gazette Notification of Labur Deptt. dated 19<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1989 the following maximum rates of pay and wages of the employes (Paid out of Contingencies) for various Deptts. in the District Ambala are revised and fixed for the year (2018-19) i.e. 01-03-2018 to 28-02-2019 as follows:

3. Minimum rates of wages have been differently fixed for the employees working PWD maintains of roads/ stones crushing PWD (PH) by labour Department.
