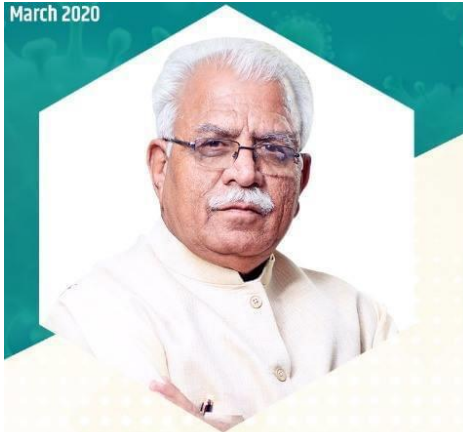

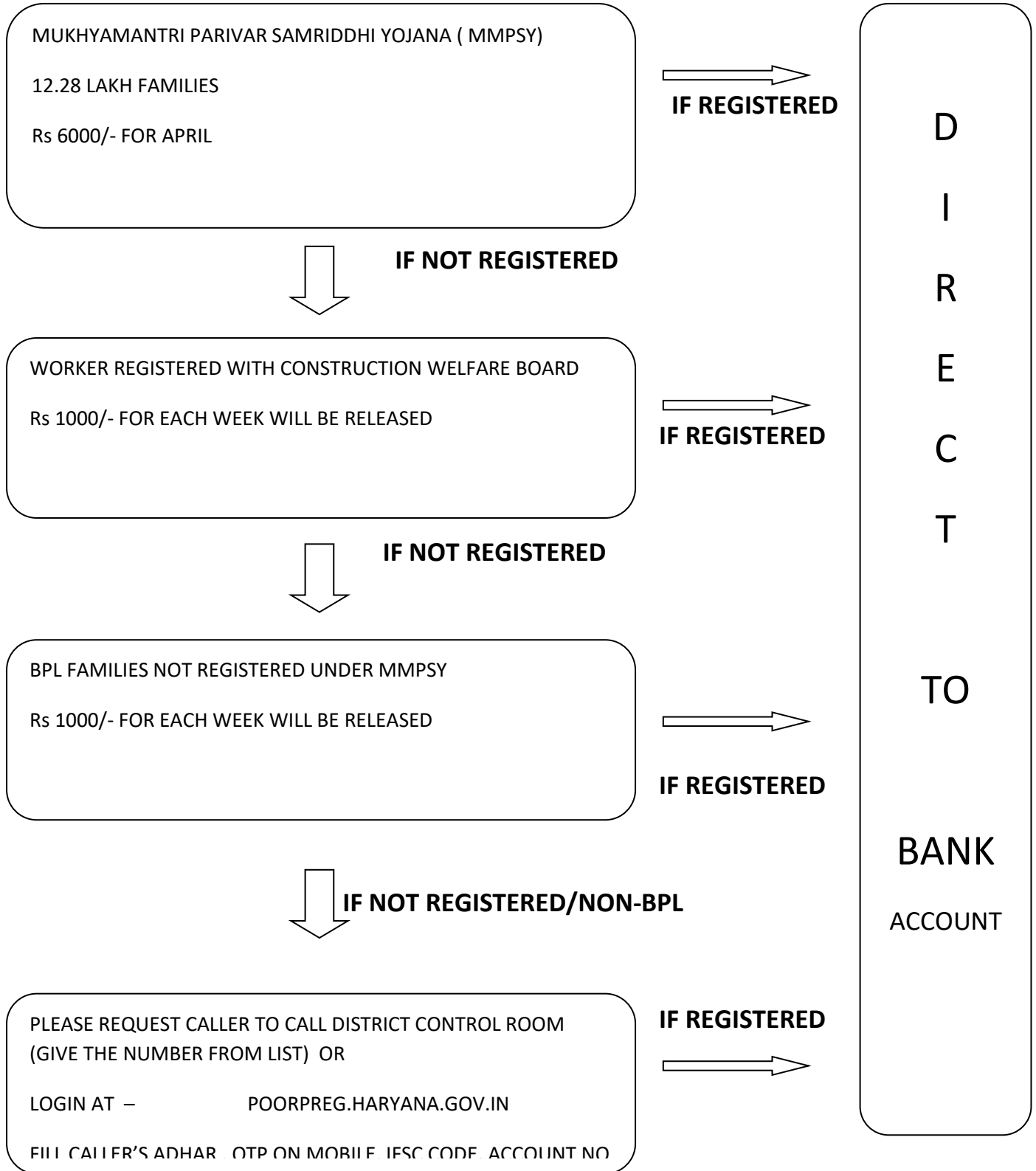

CHAPTER 1

Police Department, Haryana

Lockdown – FAQs

1. What is meant by “Lockdown” as imposed by Govt. of Haryana?

It is a situation where because of a public health emergency all public and private offices/shops/establishments are closed by law (except those exempted) and restrictions are imposed on movement of people.

2. Under which law has the lockdown been ordered?

It has been ordered under the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897.

3. In which districts is the lockdown applicable and till when?

It is applicable to the entire State of Haryana for next 21 days

4. What will happen if you don't obey the lockdown order?

You are liable to be arrested and prosecuted under section 188, 269, 270 or 271 IPC.

5. Who are allowed to move from home to his place of work?

Only those persons who are employed for in the list of essential services indicated in the **list of essential services as per Annexure 'B'** are allowed to go for work. They should however follow the social distancing norms and not travel in groups of more than 5. All other citizens are strongly advised to remain home and not proceed for work.

6. What should I do if I need to buy essential items?

You may go to buy only essential items to the store/shop in your locality. However, to minimize the chance of infection you should either be alone or at most be accompanied by one family member and should follow the social distancing norms.

7. What is the meaning of a prohibition order under section 144 Cr.PC?

A prohibition order is also in force in Haryana which restricts assembly of 5 or more persons for any purposes except mentioned above.

8. Are religious/social/political/marriage gatherings allowed?

Any gathering in which 5 or more persons are expected is NOT allowed.

- 9. I am a businessman and my industry is not listed in the list of essential services. What should I do?**

Please approach your local Deputy Commissioner of the district for resolution.

- 10. My child, parents or relative has to go to Delhi/Chandigarh/another state for some urgent work or to reach back home, what should I advise him?**

Everyone should stay wherever they are till the lockdown is lifted.

CHAPTER 2 (ANNEXURE – B)

List of Industries/establishment/services which are allowed to remain open during lockdown.

- i. Transport Services of all kinds to and from hospitals, airports, railways station, bus terminals/bus stands and for the purpose essential services.
- ii. Rail (Goods) and Air.
- iii. Electricity, Water, Sewerage and Municipal Services.
- iv. Bank, ATM, Financial, Services including Insurance.
- v. Print, Electronic and Social Media.
- vi. Telecom & Internet Services including IT Enabled Services to support essential Services
- vii. Postal/Courier Services.
- viii. Supply chain and related transportation.
- ix. Manufacturing units engaged in production of essential commodities, agriculture commodities & agriculture inputs, food items and wholesalers, retailers of such items.
- x. E-Commerce (delivery) of all essential goods including food, pharmaceutical and medical equipment.
- xi. Food, Groceries, Milk, Bread, Fruit, Fish, Atta etc. and their transportation related activities and warehousing.
- xii. Take away/ home delivery restaurant/ entries.
- xiii. Hospitals, Chemist shops, Optical stores, Pharmaceuticals manufacturing units including mask and sanitizers material manufacturing units and their transportation related activities.
- xiv. Animal feed, Veterinary Drugs and its inputs.
- xv. Petrol pumps, LPG gas, Oil agencies, their godown and their transportation related activities.
- xvi. Security services.
- xvii. Production and Manufacturing Units which require continuous subject to such restriction (including transportation) as imposed by the concerned Deputy Commissioner and after obtaining permission from the Deputy Commissioner.
- xviii. Private establishment that support the above services or are linked to the efforts for containment of COVID-19.

Note:- If there is any doubt as to whether a services is essential or not, the Collector and District Magistrate shall be the competent authority to decide. Government officers/ establishments will remain open as per the instructions of Chief Secretary Office, Haryana.

Answer:- The annual income of the parents should not be above 2.00 lac.

Answer:- 31-03-2020 is the last date for applying under section 134-A through online.
