

## **ORDER**

In compliance of Order No. DMC-SPIO-2020/13520 dated 09-11-2020 passed by Chief Secretary-cum-Chairperson, Haryana State Executive Committee, wherein it is directed to ensure the implementation of the order of Hon'ble NGT dated 09-11-2020 (OA No. 249/2020) regarding ban against sale or use of all kinds of fire crackers in all sites/towns in the country where the average of ambient air quality during November (as per available data of last year) fall under 'poor' and above category.

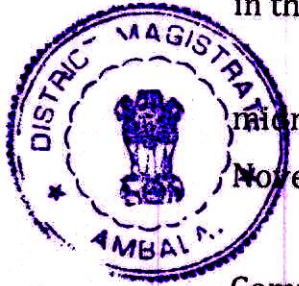
And Whereas as per report received from Regional Officer, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Ambala the average of ambient air quality in the month of November, 2019 was 'poor' and in the month of November, 2020 till now it is 'very poor' and whereas I am satisfied that for immediate compliance of the aforesaid order of Hon'ble NGT, a complete ban is to be imposed on the sale and use of any kind of fire crackers in the District Ambala.

Therefore, I, Ashok Kumar Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, Ambala, do hereby order a complete ban on the sale and use of any kind of fire crackers in the territorial limits of District Ambala.

This order shall come in to force with immediate effect from midnight of November, 10-11-2020 and will remain in force till midnight of November 30<sup>th</sup>/December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

The Superintendent of Police, Ambala, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, All Sub Divisional Magistrates, City Magistrate, Ambala, All Tehsildars, Naib Tehsildars, DSPs, CMC, EO/Secy, Municipal Council/Committees, SHOs of all Police Stations and Assistant Divisional Fire Officer, Ambala and other fire department staff shall ensure the compliance of this order. All officers are directed to conduct raids, along with SHO concerned, wherever necessary and initiate penal action if warranted. Any violation this order would be punishable u/s 188 of IPC and explosive Act. 1884/Explosive Rules 2008, and any other provision applicable in this regard for the time being in force.

The District Public Relation Officer, Ambala shall give wide publicity to this order throughout the District Ambala and this order should also be sent to press for wide publicity. DIO, Ambala is directed to upload the order on official website.



It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large, individually
