

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973**

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of disturbance of public peace and tranquility on account of nCOVID-19 Pandemic. Immediate measures are needed to be taken for prevention of such danger to human health and safety of general public, hence there is apprehension of spread of nCOVID-19 in case of public gathering.

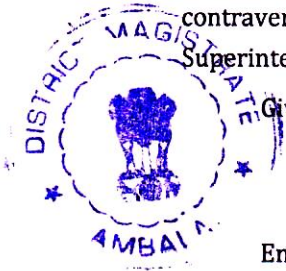
Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Ashok Kumar Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, Ambala do hereby prohibit the gathering of four or more than four persons in public places in the jurisdiction of district Ambala without permission of competent authority. Even in case the assembly is less than four persons, it will be ensured that social distancing norms circulated by the Govt. of India in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) time to time will be followed.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force till further order if not revoked earlier. This order shall not apply to the Police/Military/Para Military Forces and other public servants on duty.

These orders shall be promulgated by announcement through the publicity van, News Papers by the Public Relations Department and by affixing of copies of these orders on notice boards of District Court, Sub Divisional Courts, Tehsils, Courts, Police Stations, Municipal Council/Municipal Committees, Panchayats and Block Offices in the District Ambala by the District Information and Public Relations Officer, Ambala.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala and Sub Divisional Magistrates in their respective areas shall be responsible for enforcement of the above prohibitory orders in letter and spirit. Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala shall be responsible for implementation of this order.
