

## ORDER

In pursuance of the directions/order issued by Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana and Chairperson, State Executive Committee, Haryana State Disaster Management Authority, Chandigarh vide Memo No. DMC-SPO-2020/6415 dated 13-06-2021 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 30 and 34 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, I Vikram, IAS, District Magistrate-cum-Chairman, District Disaster Management Authority, Ambala do hereby extend the **Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana** "महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा" for another one week i.e. from **14-06-2021 (05:00 AM onwards) to 21-06-2021 (till 05:00 AM)** in District Ambala alongwith guidelines to be implemented (during the period) issued vide orders No. 2086/MA dated 02-05-2021, 2210/MA dated 10-05-2021, 2285/MA dated 16-05-2021, 2423/MA dated 23-05-2021, 2515/MA dated 30-05-2021 & 2559/MA dated 06-06-2021.

All Colleges, Coaching Institutions, ITIs, Libraries and Training Institutes whether Government or Private shall remain closed till further orders in the district Ambala.

However, some relaxations are hereby provided in modification of earlier order issued vide this office No. 2559/MA dated 06-06-2021 :-

- a. All shops are allowed to open from 09:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- b. Malls are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- c. Restaurants and bars (including in hotels and in malls) are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with 50% of the seating capacity and adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms. Home delivery from hotels, restaurants and fast food joints is permitted upto 10:00 PM.
- d. Religious places are allowed to open with 21 persons at one time with the condition that they follow requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- e. Corporate Offices are permitted to open with 50% attendance after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- f. Gatherings in weddings, Funerals/Cremations are allowed upto 21 persons. However, weddings can take place at places other than home and Courts also. No movement of 'Barat' procession will be allowed.



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- g. For gatherings other than weddings, funerals/cremations, the maximum number allowed will be 50. For gatherings more than 50, prior permission from the Deputy Commissioner shall be required.
- h. Club houses/ restaurants/ bars of the Golf Courses are allowed to open with 50% seating capacity from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with adherence to requisite social distancing and other safety norms. Members/visitors shall be allowed to play in Golf Courses by the management in a staggered manner so as to avoid overcrowding.
- i. Gyms are allowed to open from 06:00 AM to 08:00 PM with 50% capacity after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms. However, Spas shall remain closed.
- j. All production units, establishments, Industries are permitted to function. However they shall strictly adhere to Covid appropriate and prescribed guidelines, behavioural norms.
- k. Sports Complexes, Stadia are permitted to open only for sports activities (spectators will not be allowed). Sports Authorities shall ensure adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation of the premises and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.



The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Ambala/District Municipal Commissioner, Ambala will ensure that the municipalities will publicize these guidelines/orders amongst the shopkeepers and also ensure that shops should be opened as per the order issued by the Govt. of Haryana. The same will be done in rural areas by the District Development & Panchayat Officer, Ambala

Sub Divisional Officers (C), will be overall incharge in their jurisdiction to keep the regular surveillance of every activity and will ensure strict enforcement of this order. Sub Divisional Officers (C) will be authorized to give permission for more than 50 gatherings other than wedding, funerals/cremations in their jurisdiction after seeking necessary NOCs from the concerned departments including police.

Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ambala shall constitute inspection Teams for regular vigilance for implementation of this order.

Any person violating these lockdown measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.

**ORDER**

Whereas vide order No. DMC-SPO/5215 dated 02.05.2021, the State Executive Committee had declared a lockdown from 03.05.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 10.05.2021 (till 05:00 am) and vide order No. DMC-SPO/5439 dated 09.05.2021, DMC-SPO-3093 dated 16.05.2021, DMC-SPO/5761 dated 23.05.2021, DMC-SPO-2020/6008 dated 30.05.2021 and subsequent order No. DMC-SPO-2020/6222 dated 06.06.2021, the same was extended as **Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana** 'महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा' from 10.05.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 17.05.2021 (till 05:00 am); 17.05.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 24.05.2021 (till 05:00 am); 24.05.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 31.05.2021 (till 05:00 am); 31.05.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 07.06.2021 (till 05:00 am) and further from 07.06.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 14.06.2021 (till 05:00 am) in the State of Haryana alongwith guidelines to be implemented during the period), respectively.

Now, after duly considering the fact although the Covid positivity rate and the number of new Covid positive cases have declined, so as to continue the preventive and the precautionary measures to contain the Covid pandemic, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 22(2)(h) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned in my capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee hereby extends the **Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana** 'महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा' for another one week, i.e., from 14.06.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 21.06.2021 (till 05:00 am) in the State of Haryana alongwith guidelines to be implemented (during this period) issued earlier vide order dated 02.05.2021 (DMC-SPO-2020/5215) and modified subsequently vide order dated 09.05.2021(DMC-SPO-2020/5439).

All Colleges, Coaching Institutions, ITIs, Libraries and Training Institutes whether Government or Private shall remain closed till further orders in the State.


However, the following relaxations are provided in modification of earlier order issued vide DMC-SPO-2020/6222 dated 06.06.2021:-

- a. All shops are allowed to open from 09:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- b. Malls are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- c. Restaurants and bars (including in hotels and in malls) are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with 50% of the seating capacity and adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms. Home delivery from hotels, restaurants and fast food joints is permitted upto 10:00 PM.
- d. Religious places are allowed to open with 21 persons at one time with the condition that they follow requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.

- e. Corporate Offices are permitted to open with 50% attendance after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- f. Gatherings in weddings, Funerals/Cremations are allowed upto 21 persons. However, weddings can take place at places other than home and Courts also. No movement of 'Barat' procession will be allowed.
- g. For gatherings other than weddings, funerals/cremations, the maximum number allowed will be 50. For gatherings more than 50, prior permission from the Deputy Commissioner shall be required.

- k. Sports Complexes, Stadia are permitted to open only for sports activities(spectators will not be allowed). Sports Authorities shall ensure adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation of the premises and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.

The Deputy Commissioners of the concerned districts are hereby directed/authorised to work out the modalities of implementing the above mentioned relaxations strictly.
