ORDER

In compliance to the General Administration Department J&K Govt. order No. 448-GAD of 2019 dated: 03-04-2019 and 472-GAD of 2019 dated:10-04-2019 regarding the declaration of Public/Paid holiday on Poll days in the forthcoming Lok Sabha Election 2019 which is going to be held in five phases in Jammu and Kashmir state and particularly in 2nd phase in 05- Udhampur Parliamentary Constituency where the Polling date is scheduled to be held on 18-04-2019.

Therefore, Under section 135-B of the Representation of the People Act 1951 and section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881. It is hereby ordered that:-


(i) 18-04-2019 shall be observed as Public holiday in District Kishtwar on account of General Elections to the Lok Sabha-2019.

(ii) 18-04-2019 shall also be observed as Paid holiday to every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertakings or any other establishment and entitled to vote in respect of District Kishtwar.

(iii) Beside it, a person who is ordinarily resident of a constituency and registered as an elector, serving/employed in a industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the constituency including casual workers shall also be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday on 18-04-2019.
