

Following decisions /directions were taken/issued in the Meeting.

1.	Collection and Segregation of Solid Waste.	<p>The EO, MC Kishtwar was directed to take concrete steps in collection and segregating the Solid Waste before disposing it at suitable place. He shall segregate the plastic bags and bottles from the solid waste and hand over the same to authorities of Pollution Control Board for recycling or reusing it in Cement Plant and Macadamization Plants.</p> <p>At Block level the BDOs shall take steps for segregating the plastic bags and bottles and dump the same at their respective Block Headquarters from where the authorities of Pollution Control Board shall collect.</p> <p>The District Officer Pollution Control Board Kishtwar/Doda shall make all necessary arrangement for lifting the plastic bags and bottles from the Block Head quarters and MC Kishtwar for its transportation.</p> <p>The BDOs (All) , EO, MC Kishtwar shall keep close liaison with District Officer Pollution Control Board Kishtwar/Doda.</p>	<p>ACD Kishtwar/BDOs ALL/District Officer Pollution Control Board Kishtwar/EO MC Kishtwar .</p>
2.	Auditing of Local Bodies	The Member Secretary DEC Kishtwar (ADC Kishtwar) shall conduct the auditing of cleanliness of MC Kishtwar under the supervision of ADDC Kishtwar.	ADDC Kishtwar/ ADC Kishtwar(Member Secretary DEP)
3.	Disposing of Biomedical Waste	The CMO Kishtwar (Member DEC) appraised that the pits have been dug in the premises of District Hospital Kishtwar where the biomedical waste and equipments after sterilizing are being disposed off. The CMO further appraised that Sh. Gopal Singh Jasrotia Proprietor Anmol Health Care village Rakhrara Vijaypur Samba was requested to lift the biomedical waste from the DH Kishtwar for its scientific disposal in the unit which he established for the purpose but he is not paying any heed to their requests. The the CMO Kishtwar and District Officer Pollution Control Board Kishtwar/Doda was directed to take the matter with him again and find out the way in the matter. 4.	Establishing of crushing unit at Kishtwar	<p>The GM, DIC Kishtwar (Member DEC) was directed to explore the possibilities for establishing of Crushing Unit for crushing the Plastic Bottles so that it could be supplied to Macadamization Plants for using the same in road surfacing.</p> <p>Further , decision was taken that the Executive Engineers PMGSY and Executive Engineers PWD(R&B) in the District shall ensure 10% crushed waste bottles be used in the Macadamization of the roads. 5.	Water Quality Check	The Executive Engineer Hydraulic Div Kishtwar was directed to collect the sample of water from every nook and corner of the District check the quality of water. The quality check of water shall be made on regular basis .	Executive Engineer, Hydraulic Div Kishtwar.
6	Collection of user charges from household in MC Kishtwar	It was decided unanimously in the meeting to enhance the user charge from existing Rs.50.00 to Rs. 100.00 from each and every household in the Municipal Limits of Kishtwar. The EO MC Kishtwar was directed to collect the user charges @ Rs. 100.00 (Rupees one hundred only) from each and every households and utilize the same for keeping the city neat and clean. A proper record of collection of user charge and its utilization shall be maintained separately.	EO, MC Kishtwar

At the end of the meeting, the District Development Commissioner, Kishtwar thanked all participants and directed them to take concrete steps in the implementation of District Environment Plan at ground level. **The Chairman DEC further directed to all the Members and Co Opt Members of District Environment Committee to go through the guidelines of NGT thoroughly and adhere the directions given therein for their effective implementation at ground level.**
