**ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 Cr.P C**

**Whereas**, it has been made to appear from the order issued by the Home Secretary to the Government of India, vide its communiqué **No.40-3/2020-DMI(A) dated 15/04/2020** that the lockdown measures for containment of COVID-19 pandemic in the West Tripura district will remain in force up to **3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2020** to contain the spread of COVID-19.

**Whereas** "COVID-19" is declared as pandemic by the WHO, and to combat the deadly disease from community spreading and to ensure safety of people residing in West Tripura District, I am fully satisfied that there are sufficient reason/ grounds for passing prohibitory orders U/S- 144 of Criminal Procedure Code (Cr. P.C), 1973 to guarantee that there is no assembly of persons in public places.

**Now Therefore**, I Dr. Mahatme **Sandeep, N., IAS, District Magistrate & Collector, West Tripura** with an objective to minimize the threat of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and maximize public safety, in exercise of the powers vested with me Under **Section 144 Cr. P.C.** do hereby direct the citizens residing in West Tripura District comply with the following instruction:-

- a) Prohibition on the assembly of 5 or more person within West Tripura District.
- b) Prohibition of Social, Political, cultural religious or other gathering /congregation within West Tripura.
- c) Prohibition and restriction on the handling or transporting any kind of weapons, licensed or otherwise.
- d) Prohibition on the movement of the public in general with the application of exceptions as laid down in the order of the Ministry of Home Affairs issued vide Order No. **40-3/2020-DM-I(A)** dated 24.03.2020 and further modified on 25.03.2020, 27.03.2020, 02.04.2020, 03.04.2020 and 10.04.2020.


This order shall come into force with effect from zero hour on **17/04/2020** and shall be effective for a period of **17 days** up to and including **03/05/2020**.

Any person or persons found to violate this order shall be punishable under section 188 IPC, 1860.

The order shall be promulgated by affixing copies thereof on the notice Board of the office of the undersigned and publication in the newspaper having circulation in the district through the Director, ICA Deptt, Government of Tripura
