NOTICE

Whereas as per report of the Deputy Secretary, Rural Development Department, Government of Tripura vide letter No. F.7(2)-RD/2019/4028 dated 24th July, 2019, **Shri Subhankar Das, LDC (Fixed Pay)** under R.D. Deptt. posted at Rural Development Department, Government of Tripura, Agartala on deputation was absenting himself from his office duty **w.e.f. 05/07/2019** to till date without attaining any prior permission from his authority concerned for his absence.

AND

Whereas no leave application has been adduced by Shri **Subhankar Das, LDC** to the Department till date in respect of his absence from his duty and such type of his absence has been contemplated as unauthorized absence from duty.

AND

Whereas consequent upon such unauthorized absence from duty, a Memo vide No. F.32(5-785)-DM/W/ESTT/2019/8411 dated 6th August, 2019 was issued to **Shri Subhankar Das, LDC (Fixed Pay)** asking him to explain within 3(three) days from the date of receipt of this Memo why disciplinary action shall not be imposed against him.

AND

Whereas Shri Subhankar Das, LDC has received this memo on 29th August 2019. But he has neither submitted the reply of this memo nor turns up physically before the authority concerned.

AND

Whereas second time opportunity has been given to Shri Subhankar Das, LDC by dint of a Memo vide No.F.32(5-785)-DM/W/ESTT/2019/1658 dated 8th July 2020 to join his duty alongwith relevant papers exhibiting the ground of such unauthorized absence within 10(ten) days from the date of receipt of this Memo. But this attempt has produced no effect. Shri Das LDC has not turned up to this office.

AND

Whereas Shri Subhankar Das, LDC was given last opportunity through a memo F.32(5-785)-DM/W/ESTT / 2019/2496 dated 21st October, 2020 to join his duty alongwith all relevant papers exhibiting the ground of such unauthorized absence within 10(ten) days from the date of receipt of this Memo, otherwise action shall be taken as per provision in force.



AND

Whereas in the said Memo dated 21st October, 2020, the Officer-in-Charge, West Agartala Police Station was requested to serve the Memo to Shri Subhankar Das, LDC and from the service return it is learnt that being found not available Shri Subhankar Das in his house, the memo was served to his uncle namely Shyamal Datta on 27/10/2020.


AND

Whereas the stipulated date as mentioned in the Memo dated 21/10/2020 for joining in the office duty has already been elapsed on 05/11/2020 but no response from the part of Shri Subhankar Das, LDC is received by this office. Shri Subhankar Das, LDC shows neither any devotion to his duty appearing physically in office nor he furnishes any reply to this Memo.

And

Whereas according to the Circular of the G.A. (P&T) Department, Government Tripura vide Memorandum No. F.20 (1)-GA(P&T)/18 (Part) dated 12/12/2018, a government servant shall be deemed to have resigned from the service if he is absent without authorization for a period of one year. The Memorandum also states that if any employee is found to be unauthorizedly absenting himself for more than one year, then action as per rules should be taken for their deemed resignation.

Now therefore Shri Subhankar Das, LDC is directed to join his duty within 15(fifteen) days from the date of publication of this notice, otherwise it will be presumed that he is no longer interested to continue his service and it will be deemed to have resigned from the service.
