ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 Cr.P C

Whereas, vide order No.F.2(1)/CS/Home/2020 dated 19th May, 2021 of the Chief Secretary it has been intimated that the situation arising out of 2nd wave of Covid Pandemic has been reviewed in details by the State Government and it is noticed by the State Government that the additional measures need to be taken to contain the transmission of the virus.

AND

Whereas, it has been ordered by the Chief Secretary, Government of Tripura in the above mentioned order that all inter-district movement of people and vehicles from one district to other district shall remain suspended **from 5 AM of 20/05/2021 up to 5 AM of 26/05/2021** including West Tripura District.

AND

Whereas, I, **Sri Raval Hamendra Kumar, IAS**, District Magistrate & Collector, West Tripura District, am fully satisfied that immediate prevention and speedy remedy is desirable and that there is sufficient ground for imposing restrictions on movement of people and vehicles from West Tripura District to other and from other district to West Tripura District to prevent danger to Public health & human life.

Now therefore, I, **Sri Raval Hamendra Kumar, IAS**, District Magistrate & Collector, West Tripura in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under **section 144 Cr. P.C, 1973** do hereby order the enforcement of the following prohibitory measures:

Restrictions:

Movement of people and vehicles from West Tripura District to other and from other district to West Tripura District shall remain suspended **w.e.f. 5 AM of 20/05/2021 to 5 AM of 26/05/2021** .

Exemption :

- 1) Movement of persons and vehicles assigned with the essential & emergency services like Law & Order, Municipal Services, Disaster Management & District Administration, Police Personnel, Military/CAPF Personnel, Health, Electricity, Fire, Drinking Water, Media persons, Jail, Courts, Homes of Social Welfare, Food & Civil Supplies, Forestry and Government Machinery assigned with COVID-19 related duties.
- 2) Movement of Government officials as per roster duty assigned by the Head of Offices.
- 3) There shall be no curbs on movement of all kinds of goods including petroleum products empty goods vehicles and loading / unloading thereof.
- 4) Movement of Buses, light vehicles / Auto & private vehicles will be allowed only for essential and emergency needs. Travel of persons to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains, and aeroplanes on production of valid tickets.
- 5) Movement of persons & vehicles related to Telecommunication, internet services broadcasting and cable services IT & IT enable services.
- 6) Movement of persons & vehicles related to delivery services of all essential goods including food, groceries, vegetables, diary & milk, meat & fish, animal fodder, Pharmaceutical medical equipments etc. including e-commerce.
- 7) Movement of persons and vehicles related to petrol pumps, LPG, CNG, petroleum and gas retail and storage outlets.
- 8) Movement of employees engaged in industries/ companies requiring operation 24 x 7 and multiple shifts, power generation, gas production, cold storage & warehouse etc shall be allowed subject to production of valid ID card issued by their respective Organization Institution.
- 9) Movement of persons and vehicles related to Bank and ATM, RBI, Insurance, IMD, NIC Customs and Land port and other financial institutions.
- 10) Movement of employees and personnel engaged in Airport/ Railway operations and cargo service.

- 11) Movement of persons engaged in Postal & Courier Services.
- 12) Personnel of private security services.
- 13) Movement of persons relating to carrying of seed fertilizer, pesticides, agricultural implements & repairing thereof.
- 14) Movement of persons and vehicles carrying goods from FCI, and other Outlets control by FCS & CA Deptt.
- 15) Movement of patients for getting medical / health services.
- 16) Movement of Electronic and Print media persons and government employees handling media issues on production of valid documents
- 17) Personnel of construction work and project activities.

Any person violating these prohibitory measures shall be liable to be prosecuted under **section 188 of IPC** and other legal provisions in force.


In view of the emergent nature of situation and with a view to ensure public health & safety this order is passed ex-parte & is addressed to public in general.

The Superintendent of Police, West Tripura shall take necessary measure to strictly enforce the above order.

The order shall be widely promulgated by the Director, ICA, Government of Tripura through electronic media & local daily newspapers.


