Office Order:

As part of the containment strategy against the spread of Covid-19 epidemic, pursuant to the guidelines issued by Government of India and Government of Maharashtra, the Aurangabad District Administration has identified Containment Zones for notification/ denotification and implementation of necessary protocols. The zones identified are exclusive of those notified/ de-notified by Aurangabad District (Rural) within its boundaries.

The following criteria shall be used for notification/denotification of the Containment Zone, to be demarcated in accordance with Government of Maharashtra letter dated 05/05/2020:

- i An area with the number of active cases of Covid-19 exceeding 5 to be notified
- ii An area with no active cases in the preceding 28 days to be de-notified

The following activities shall be implemented in accordance with the guidelines:

- i Intensive monitoring of the Containment Zone:
- ii Contact tracing.
- iii Home quarantining of individuals based on risk assessment of competent officers
- iv Testing of all cases with Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), Influenza Like Illness (ILI) and other symptoms specified by MoHFW, Government of India
- v House to house surveillance by special teams constituted for this purpose
- vi Clinical management of all cases as per protocol
- vii Counselling and educating people; and establishing effective communication strategies
- viii Strict perimeter control
- ix. Any other measures prescribed in applicable guidelines/rules

The following area are de notified as Containment zones in Aurangabad District –
(An area with no active cases in the preceding 28 days to be de-notified)

The data collection efforts in the notified zones shall be undertaken as per the format at Annexure 1. The indicative demarcation of the notified Containment Zones is at Annexure 2 The district administration shall notify/de-notify Containment Zones from time to time in accordance with applicable guidelines.

A list of all notified/de-notified Containment Zones shall be hosted on the website of the District Administration and disseminated through mobile applications and dashboards for wider reach and awareness.

The head of the taluka within which the Containment Zone is notified /de notified shall be the Incident Commander for the implementation of the protocols specified herein.
