Subject: **Measures to prevent the spread of Corona virus – Declaration of Red Zone and Buffer Zones thereof.**

ORDER

Whereas, a series of orders/communications stand issued by this office under the provisions of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Criminal Procedure Code to contain and check the spread of Corona virus (COVID-19) and;

Whereas, two Covid-19 positive cases have been detected in the District today, one is the resident of village Fazalabad, Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch and the other one in Quarantine Centre Christ School Poonch;

Whereas, one of the positive person came in contact with a number of persons during his official duties and routine mundane activities which has made some areas/villages vulnerable to further transmission of COVID-19 virus;

Whereas, in order to check the further transmission and break the chain of COVID-19 infection in the area, it has become imperative to take further stringent precautionary measures viz declaring the area/location as Red Zone/Containment zone and its surrounding areas as Buffer Zones;

Now, therefore, in view of the above and in the interest of safety and well-being of general public, I, Rahul Yadav, IAS, District Magistrate, Poonch in exercise of powers vested in me under section 144 CrPC, section 34 of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and section 3 of Epidemics Diseases Act, 1897 do hereby order as follows: -

1. That High School, Fazalabad is declared as Quarantine Centre for these persons and area within the radius of 300 metres of this quarantine centre is declared as **containment zone**.
2. That the village namely Fazalabad is hereby declared as **Red Zone** and Quarantine Centre Christ School Poonch is hereby declared as **Containment Zone**. The staff deputed at Christ School Poonch shall follow the necessary SOP. Additional Security shall be deployed to restrict the movement from this Quarantine Centre.
3. That the adjoining villages namely Pamrote, Dandi Dhara, Dhara Mohra and Sanglani are declared as **Buffer Zones**.
4. That there shall be no inward/outward movement of any person from these villages and inhabitants shall stay at their homes.
5. There shall be complete lockdown in the villages namely Pamrote, Dandi Dhara, Dhara Mohra and Sanglani.
6. That there will be no vehicular movement on the inner roads of the aforesaid villages/areas.
7. Executive Officer, Municipality Surankote shall sanitize the area as per Protocol.
8. Block Medical Officer, Surankote under the supervision of Chief Medical officer, Poonch shall thoroughly conduct the process of contact tracing as per Protocol including complete survey of 300 meter radius of such village where the aforesaid COVID-19 positive person stayed and the institution where he performed his duties. Screening and regular health check up of the inhabitants of the village shall also be ensured. BMO shall dedicate one ambulance for the said area.
9. That the following officers/officials shall act as Administrators at the villages/places shown against them: -
 - i) Mr. Khalid Qureshi, Lecturer (9797577514) shall act as Administrator for Red Zone.

ii) Mr. Zakir Hussain Shah, JE (9419647261) shall act as Administrator for the Buffer villages namely Pamrote and Dandi Dhara.

iii) Mr. Imtiaz Hussain Shah Kazmi, Lecturer (700659047) shall act as Administrator for the Buffer villages namely Dhara Mohra and Sanglani.

Further, the Administrator of the Red Zone shall ensure screening the households and submit the information to this office on daily basis on 3:00 PM. The Administrator shall ensure the availability of basic facilities including food grains, LPG, medicines in Red and Buffer Zones.

10. The Hospital/Institutional Quarantine of the contacts shall be ensured by the CMO Poonch as per Protocol.
11. Concerned Tehsildar/SHO/TSO shall ensure supply of essential commodities in the area as per laid down Protocol.
12. The contact no. of COVID-19 Control No. 01965-222012, 9622126247, 9906207654, 01965-222079 (Medical Emergency) shall be widely circulated among the population so that the information with regard to any suspect shall be shared by locals with the authorities. The inhabitants can also call on aforesaid contact numbers in case of any medical emergency.
13. Any person (s)/group/institution found violating the direction mentioned supra shall be booked under the relevant provisions of the law.
