Subject: - Measures to prevent the spread of Corona virus – Partial de-notification of Red Zone thereof.

**ORDER**

Whereas, a series of orders/communications stand issued by this office under the provisions of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Criminal Procedure Code to contain and check the spread of Corona virus (COVID-19); and,

Whereas, Covid-19 positive case were detected in the district with primary contacts at places mentioned below. Accordingly, these areas were declared as Red Zones vide this office Order No: (mentioned against each) under the provisions of the Acts mentioned in Para-1.

Whereas, area Magistrates/Nodal Officers were deployed in these areas. All mandated protocols were followed as per SOP issued by the Government of UT of J&K and the red zone areas were put under complete lockdown to ensure arrest of further transmission in other areas. Intensive testing including testing of persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women, those above 50 years of age and those with ILI/SARI symptoms was carried out. All service providers and health care workers attending to people in the red zones were also sampled. Further, full door to door health screening and surveillances were conducted in these areas to rule out any hidden source of infection.

Whereas, the Government of UT of J&K has issued specific guidelines for partial de-notification of Red zone areas vide Govt order No:- 63-JK(DMRRR) of 2020 Dated:- 24-06-2020.

Whereas , as reported by Chief medical officer Poonch, there has been no fresh case of COVID-19 in the areas of the Red zones mentioned above in the last 21 days. As per the specific guidelines for de-notification dated:-24-06-2020 , tests results of the travelers of the containment zones , already under the quarantine from the date of arrival in the district are not to be considered as fresh positive cases from the containment zone.

Now , therefore in the light of facts mentioned above and in the interest of public in general, the Red zones mentioned above are hereby partially de-notified w.e.f 23-08-2020.

Moreover, as per guidelines issued by Government of UT of Jammu & Kashmir vide order No: 63-JK (DMRRR) of 2020 dated: 24-06-2020 the Block Medical officers concerned shall ensure the followup and random sampling of 10% of the residents of these areas and carry out other containment related measures like ensuring that all the residents

within this zone having smart phone download and install Arogaya Setu App.

The order of partial de-notification shall be subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. These areas shall be fully de-notified if no confirmed COVID positive case reported for the next 10 days and if confirmed COVID positive case is reported, the concerned area shall again be notified as Red/ Containment zone.
2. No Public transport shall be allowed to ply in these areas.
3. Daily service/commodities during the period of partial relaxation shall be operated as under:-

4. All the guidelines /Instructions regarding universal wearing of face mask, social distancing etc. shall be strictly enforced.

All the nodal Officers/Police personnel deployed shall remain intact.

Full de-notification shall be subject to the fulfillment of all the guidelines issued by Government of UT of Jammu & Kashmir vide order No: 63-JK (DMRRR) of 2020 dated: 24-06-2020.
