Subject: -Restrictions for Covid Containment- reg.

Ref: - Government Order vide No: 22-JK(DMRRR) of 2021 dated: 20-04-2021.

ORDER

Whereas, State Executive Committee, Department of Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction, J&K has issued fresh Order vide No: 22-JK(DMRRR) of 2021 dated: 20-04-2021 para (c) of which reads as under: -

"Only 50% shops in major Market Complexes/ Bazars/Malls within Municipal limits/Urban Local Body Limits shall be opened on alternative basis through a rotation system. District Magistrates of all Districts shall device a pattern to implement this, preferably in consultation with local market Associations. This shall take effect from 21-04-2021"

And whereas, detailed discussions were held with President Beopal Mandal Association Poonch and Presidents of various Market Associations, Poonch/Surankote on 19-04-2021 and 20-04-2021 in person as well as telephonically;

And whereas, in view of the directions mentioned in para Supra as well as after deliberations with the representatives of Market Associations, I, **Inder Jeet**, KAS, District Magistrate, Poonch in exercise of powers vested in me u/s 34 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and section 144 of CrPC do, hereby, order that the shops/establishments shall be allowed to open/operate within the Municipal Limits/Urban Local Body Limits of District Poonch as per schedule given below: -

11	Readymade garments and shoes shops

Any shop/establishment not mentioned above shall operate on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.


However, these shops/establishments on their days of opening shall be allowed to operate with the conditions that SOPs related to COVID-19 including maintaining social distance, wearing of face masks and placing of sanitizers at the entrance shall be strictly followed.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect on 21st of April 2021 and shall remain in force till further order.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general. It shall be circulated in print, electronic, social media for information of all concerned.

Any violation of this order shall invite action as per the provisions of section 188 of the IPC and other legal provisions as applicable.
