ORDER

Whereas, this office had issued instructions vide Order NO: DMP/PA/431-45 dated: 21-04-2021 following the instructions issued by State Executive Committee Department of Disaster Management Relief, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction vide NO: 22-JK(DMRRR) of 2021 dated: 20-04-2021, wherein only 50% shops in major Market Complexes/ Bazars/Malls within Municipal limits/Urban Local Body Limits were allowed to opened on alternative basis through a rotation system; And

whereas, in view of the fact that district Poonch has seen sudden spike in covid -19 cases in recent days, feed back received from various stakeholders including market associations and Weekend lockdown being enforced in the district, DDMA is of the view that it is imperative to affect some modifications in the order issued earlier.

Therefore, I, Inder Jeet, KAS, District Magistrate, Poonch in exercise of powers vested in me u/s 34 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and section 144 of CrPC do, hereby, order that the shops/establishments shall be allowed to open/operate within the Municipal Limits/Urban Local Body Limits as well as town of Mendhar and Mandi of District Poonch as per schedule given below: -

Any shop/establishment not mentioned above shall operate on Monday, and Wednesday upto 1:00 p.m.


However, these shops/establishments on their days of opening shall be allowed to operate with the conditions that SOPs related to COVID-19 including maintaining of social distance, wearing of face masks and placing of sanitizers at the entrance shall be strictly followed.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect on 5th of May, 2021 and shall remain in force till further order.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general. It shall be circulated in print, electronic, social media for information of all concerned.

Any violation of this order shall invite action as per the provisions of section 188 of the IPC and other legal provisions as applicable.
