



Subject: - COVID-19 CONTAINMENT & MANAGEMENT – Order under section 144 of Cr. P. C. read with section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 - Weekend Lockdown in District Rajouri.

ORDER No: 131 -DMR of 2020
DATED:- 24 -07-2020

Whereas, during aggressive tracking/tracing and RT-PCR sampling of targeted groups viz vendors/Labourers/Service providers and travellers in the District, spike in COVID-19 cases has been noticed in the past few days, which requires to be dealt with immediate preventive measures to check further spread of Corona Virus to minimize the danger to human life; and

Whereas, section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, empowers the undersigned to issue certain directions for safety and preventing any harm to human life from any pandemic; and

Whereas, on the basis of the inputs obtained from the health authorities and after due consultation with all the stakeholders associated with the containment and management of COVID-19, it is necessitated that advisories/instructions and orders issued by the Ministry of Home affairs, Health and Family Welfare Department, GoI and UT of Jammu and Kashmir, for containment of COVID-19, must be followed by the public like Covering of face/social distancing norms/Hand washing etc during all the days and **strict lockdown during weekends need to be followed to prevent any further spike in the COVID cases.**

Now, therefore, I, **Mohammed Nazir Sheikh, District Magistrate, Rajouri** in view of above and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 of Cr. P. C. read with section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, do hereby ordered that:

1. There shall be complete weekend lockdown commencing from today (24.07.2020) **from 8:00 PM Friday to 6:00 AM on Monday & shall continue following every week** in the territorial jurisdiction of District Rajouri. However, **restrictions imposed in the containment/Red Zone and areas declared as locked down**, shall be regulated by the various orders issued in this regard.
2. There shall be complete restriction on movement of individuals, vehicles and all activities within the entire jurisdiction of the district, except the movement for emergency/medical requirements for which no pass is required.
3. Only local Chemist/Medicine Shops, Fruits/ Vegetables/Meat Shops and Milk Dairy Shops can remain accessible for community needs observing all guidelines/SOPs and;
4. The employees of the essential services departments and those associated with the COVID-19 management across the District, shall be allowed to

- move with in area of their respective responsibility, on production of valid ID Proof;
5. Emergency Services of **AH&GMC Rajouri, SDH Sunderbani, CHC Nowshera, CHC Darhal, CHC Kalakote, CHC Thannamandi, CHC Teryath, SDH Kandi, PHC Manjakote and PHC Budhal** & other Health facilities shall remain functional, to deal with any emergency, under the close supervision of concerned Administrative Officers.
 6. No curfew pass shall be issued in any case.
 7. There shall be no bar on Govt. Constructions and Agriculture related activities except in the containment/Red Zone and areas declared as Locked down.
 8. There shall be no restriction on the Movement of Goods Carrier/Oil/LPG Tankers.

Since, it is not possible to serve prior notice of this order, it is as such being issued ex-parte. **Any violation of this order shall invite punitive action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code and relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.**

This order shall be widely circulated for information of all, by the District Information Officer, Rajouri.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Rajouri shall ensure the enforcement of the restrictions during the weekend Lockdown.
