MINUTES OF DTF MEETING

I. 5th meeting of District Task Force was held under the Chairmanship of District magistrate (South East) on 16-06-2014 at 3.00 PM in his chamber. A list of participants is enclosed at Annexure 'A'.

II. At the outset, District Magistrate welcomed all the participants of the meeting. The DM reiterated the importance of work assigned to the District Task Force and directed all land owning agencies to ensure that all ongoing unauthorised constructions and encroachments on agricultural/public land must be stopped and demolished.

The following was discussed and decided in the meeting.

III. DDA: (1) Demolition of Kh. 421/260 (min) 486/261 (min) (Area -29-12) of village Joga Bai to be conducted on 09.06.2014 had been decided in the last meeting, for which joint inspection was scheduled for 03.06.2014. A report dated 10.06.2014 of SHO Jamia Nagar P.S. is on record which informs that DDA officers did not turn up on 03.06.2014 as decided and they did not turn up on a further date of 07.06.2014 too when they were directed to conduct the joint survey of the referred land. A fresh joint survey of the referred Kh. No. has been requested a part from fixing a fresh date for demolition programme.

Dy. Director (LM/SEZ) of DDA, Sh. Rajesh Kumar informed that the joint survey of the said khasras had already been done at an earlier occasion with the local police and showed the related documents. The chairman impressed upon him that the departments/officers participating in the DTF meeting are supposed to act according to the decisions taken in the meeting and need to avoid making/taking unilateral assumptions/decisions.

It was decided that DDA and local police will conduct a joint inspection of Kh. No. 421/260 (min) and 486/261 (min) Area -29-12) of village Joga Bai on 23-06-2014. Meeting point and time was fixed to be P.S. Jamia Nagar at 10.00 A.M. Demolition programme was fixed for 25.06.2014.

(2) Dy. Director LM/SEZ DDA informed that the building activities in village Jaitpur are under SDMC jurisdiction as the area had been de-notified by L&B Deptt. of GNCTD vide notification no. F.12(49)/09/L&B/Plg./516 dt. 19.04.2011, which gives the description of the de-notified areas. He also submitted a copy of the notification which was also provided to the SDMC and other departments. Accordingly SDMC is required to take action on unauthorised building activities in Jaitpur village and others village falling in 'O' zone.

(Action: SDMC)

SDMC: (1) Chairman asked the DC (Central), SDMC to submit a detailed report on taken in Tamoor Nagar on 05.06.2014.

2) SDMC representatives pointed out some encroachment on DDA land near outfall of or Nagar Drain and informed that if the same was not removed, it would create lems in the area due to back flow in the drain near Kalindi Kunj. It was decided that would conduct a joint survey with SDMC and local police on 19.06.2014 to assess the ation for necessary planning for the demolition. Demolition programme was fixed for 06.2014 for removal of structure in the bed of the drain affecting flow of the water.

(3) SDMC representatives also pointed out an encroachment by 6 jhuggies on the bed the Barapulla Drain in Nizamuddin area near Barapuliya. It was informed that a survey by USIB had already been conducted a fortnight ago in this regard. It was decided that a joint rvey by SDMC, DUSIB and local police would be conducted on 19.06.2014 and demolition programme would be taken up on 23.06.2014. Meeting point and time was fixed to be P.S. Nizamuddin at 10.00 A.M.

(Action: SDMC & Police)

V. **PWD:** Representatives of divisions M-411 and M-412 informed that there was no encroachment of permanent nature on their roads. Some instances of temporary encroachments were reported to being removed by them periodically. It was decided to repeat the encroachment removal action on PWD road.

Some such encroachments were reported on Captain Gaur Marg and Maa Anand Mai Marg, for which a joint inspection of PWD concerned division and local police was decided to be conducted on 23.06.2014. Demolition programme for Captain Gaur Marg was fixed for 25.06.2014 and Maa Anandmai Marg, was fixed 26.06.2014.

(Action: PWD & Police)

VI. **Absentee departments:** (1) CEO DUSIB had been requested through the meeting notice to depute Director (Slums) to attend this meeting while Dy. Conservator of Forest South/South East had also been invited for this meeting through the meeting notice. But representatives of DUSIB and Forest department did not make it to the meeting.

It was decided to request the **CEO DUSIB** as well as **Conservator of Forests** to take note of the absence of their representatives in the DTF meeting and direct that Director (Slums) and Dy. Conservator of Forest South/South East do attend the DTF meetings in future, especially when so invited.

(Action: DUSIB & Forest Deptt.)

VII. Chairman requested all the participants to make it a point to submit formal Action Taken Report on the decisions concerning them taken in the previous DTF meeting in any subsequent meeting. Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
