OFFICE ORDER

Whereas one case of COVID-19 has been tested positive from the village-Sulsulia, GP.- Nuagarh, Block-Bhatli, PS-Bhatli, Dist.- Bargarh,

Whereas the surveillance team while tracking the contacts of the positive case of village Sulsulia, has reported that the positive tested person had gone to village Narangpur to visit one of his relative's house along with another relative from village Sirapali in a motor bike on 22.05.2020,

Whereas the objective of the administration is to go for immediate geographic quarantine, social distancing, enhanced active surveillance, ensure testing of all suspected cases and compulsory home quarantining of the contact cases and their isolation as per need,

Whereas the Collector & District Magistrate, Bargarh, has been empowered u/s 8 of Covid-19 Regulations- 2020, framed by the Government of Odisha, to take effective measures for containment zone of epidemic which has already been declared pandemic,

Whereas the District Disaster Management Authority has been empowered to take necessary measures u/s 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act to prevent the spread of this disaster.

Now, therefore, for larger public interest, I, Sri Jyotiranjana Pradhan, OAS(SAG), Collector & DM, Bargarh, orders implementation of the following directions.

BOUNDARY OF ZONE OF CONTAINMENT (MAP ATTACHED)

The containment-zone shall comprise of the boundary as delineated below.

- **Narangpur revenue village, GP- Narangpur, Block/PS-Bhatli, Dist.-Bargarh.**
- **Sirapali revenue village, GP-Kharmunda, Block/PS-Bhatli, Dist.-Bargarh.**

The vehicular movement both public and private is stopped in totality in the containment zone, excluding the vehicles permitted for supply of essential items, medicines, health surveillance, sanitization and other necessary activities to be undertaken by the District Administration and to be used by the police for enforcement of Law and Order and in conformity to stipulations. All the shops and business establishments irrespective of the scale and size in the Containment-zone shall be closed with immediate effect. The supply chain of medicine and other essential items shall be kept uninterrupted by the District Administration.

All the inhabitants of the Containment-zone shall stay in-door and this is to be followed without deviation. Violation shall invite strict penal action. The institutions and establishments in the Containment-zone enjoying exemption of lockdown in the Containment area shall remain closed. All the Government and Private Institutions in the Containment zone are closed. The closure and seizure of operation as enunciated in the order of lockdown i.e. No.5059/Emg. Dated 18.05.2020 shall be adhered to and the exemption allowed therein shall cease to operate in the Containment zone. The following officers shall act as Nodal Officers to ensure smooth supply of essentials and sanitization of the Containment-zone.

1. Ms.Kabita Agasti, Inspector of Supplies - Supply of Essential Commodities.
2. Sri Pramod Kumar Oram, JE, Bhatli Block - Maintenance of sanitation and sanitization of the areas.
3. Sri Ramakrushna Mishra, ORS, Additional Tahasildar, Bhatli- Maintenance of Law and Order.
4. Dr. Sadhu Charan Dash, DHH, Bargarh- Health Requirement.
5. Dr. Chulabati Sahu, DPHO, Bargarh - Surveillance and contact tracing.
6. Overall supervision shall be done by the Sub-Collector, Bargarh.
7. Superintendent of Police, Bargarh, shall make necessary arrangement for immediate deployment of adequate police force at the points of requirement to be supervised either by the Additional Superintendent of Police, Bargarh or SDPO, Bargarh.

CONTACT TRACING

Contacts of the confirmed and suspected cases shall be line listed, tracked and shall be kept under surveillance at home for 28 days.

SURVEILLANCE

The area of Containment shall be under active surveillance. CDM&PHO, Bargarh, shall mobilize required work force immediately to conduct the exercise in respect of all the houses in the Containment-zone. Supervisory Officers shall also be named by the CDM&PHO, Bargarh, at a ratio of 1:4. The active surveillance shall start from 31.05.2020 at 08.00 AM in the morning. The visiting teams shall advise the families to use face mask compulsorily and to maintain social distancing. All ILI and SARI cases either reported during the last 14 days by the IDSP or ascertained in course of our across-the district exercise shall be tracked and reviewed thoroughly in the Containment zone. Swab shall be collected from all the cases of confirmed contact at the earliest for testing at the designated Labs.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain as such until the same is either rescinded or withdrawn.

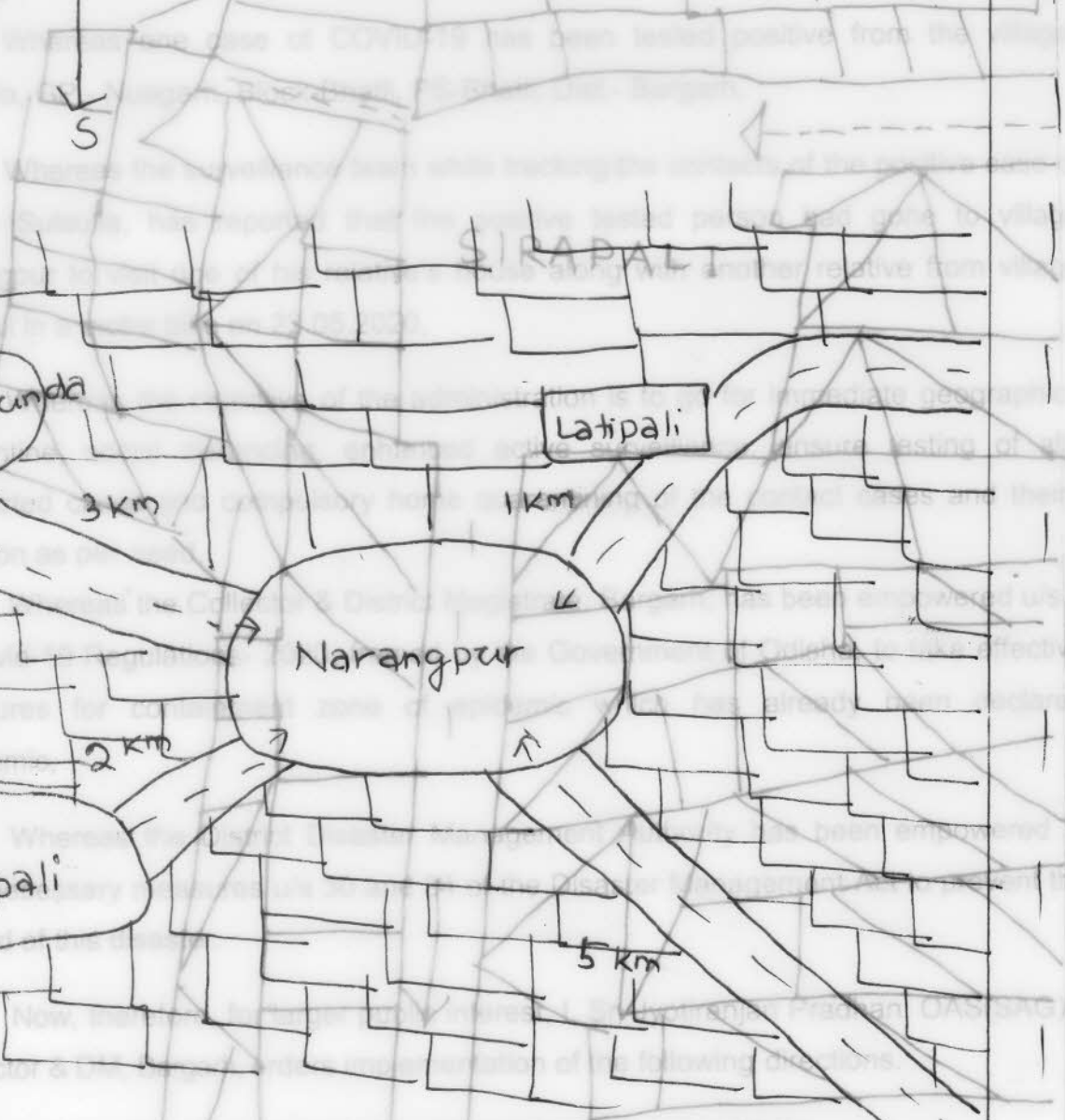

The containment zone shall be the area within the boundary as delineated below.

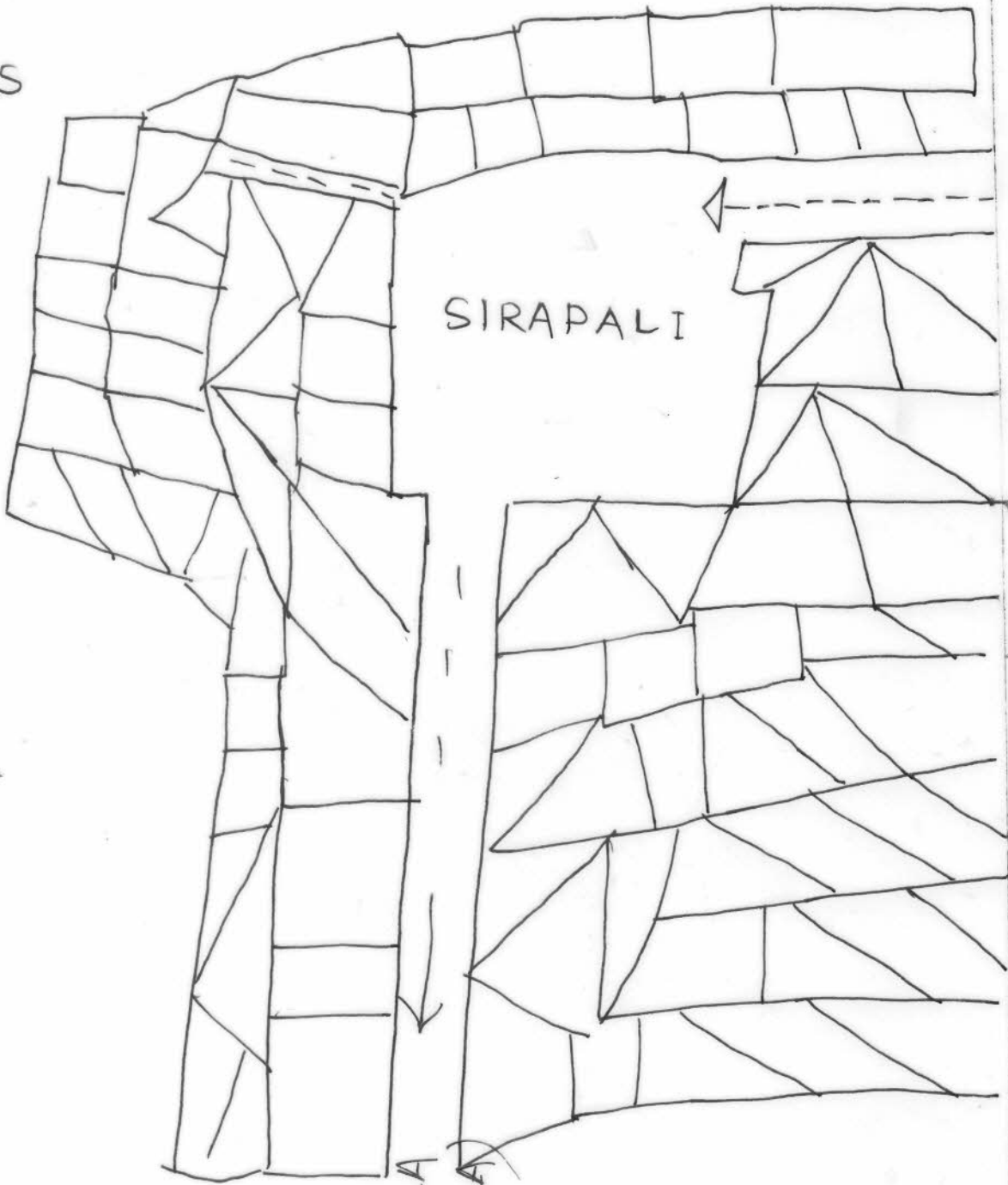
- Narangpur revenue village, GP- Narangpur, Block/PS-Bhatli, Dist.-Bargarh.
