 - ✓ It processes cases for 'cash awards/land, annuity and other concessions'.
 - ✓ Grants financial assistance to the families of the defense personnel killed/disabled.
 - ✓ Organizes rallies for ex-servicemen
 - ✓ The department administers the Punjab amalgamated funds.
 - ✓ Provides grants to ex-servicemen for the marriage of their daughters.
 - ✓ Nominations of vice president and non-official members of zila Sainik boards.
 - ✓ Assist in admission to RIMC and Sainik schools.
 - ✓ Process cases of widows/next of kins of Operation Vijay & other such operations.
- Settlement of financial problems such as pension and other Retirement/Release benefits/Dues,
Grants and assistance in kind to ex-servicemen.
