ORDER:-

Whereas to contain the spread of Covid-19, a complete lockdown was announced in the state of Punjab and Curfew was imposed in district Pathankot vide no. 1710-57/M.A dated 23.03.2020 which has been further extended and now it is extended till 17.05.2020.

Now I, **Gurpreet Singh Khaira, IAS, District Magistrate Pathankot** in exercise of powers confirmed upon me under section 144 of CrPC 1973 allow certain relaxations in curfew.

How these relaxations will not be given hot spots areas and Containment Zones.

It is hereby ordered that: -

The Hotels, Restaurants, Dhabas, Eateries in District Pathankot are allowed to operate for delivering food at the door steps of the customers and will not allow any person at their premises and will operate with shutters closed from 7 AM to 7 PM subject to the condition:


- A. Dining will not be allowed**
- B. Hygiene standards to be maintained at workplace: -**
- (i) Restaurants have to record temperature of all employees coming to the restaurant on a daily basis and maintain record of that.
 - (ii) Frequent cleaning/disinfection of work surfaces and touch points such as door handles.
 - (iii) Face mask is mandatory for all employees and must be changed every day.
 - (iv) Maintain social distancing while at work.
 - (v) Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizers to be practiced.
- C. Guidelines to be followed during home delivery of food: -**
- (i) The deliverable food item should be cooked and packed hygienically.
 - (ii) Delivery/transport vehicles shall be cleaned and sanitized regularly.
 - (iii) Zero contact delivery while delivering food to the guest and contact with common touch points such as door bell should be avoided.
 - (iv) Face Mask/Gloves are mandatory for all delivery workers.
 - (v) Medical Screening and record of all the delivery boys has to be maintained by the owner and also record has to be maintained of daily delivery calls with complete details/address.

These guidelines are illustrative and not exhaustive. All concerned to follow the COVID-19 management guidelines issued by Government from time to time.

Anyone found violating the COVID-19 guidelines will be liable for strict action under the provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
