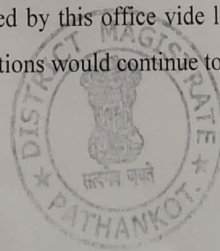


Order

Keeping in view the larger public interest in the scenario of emerging threat of Pandemic Covid-19, In continuous to earlier order No. MA/5234-5256 dated 01-09-2020 and keeping in view of latest guidelines received from the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh vide no SS/ACSH/2020/623 dated 19.09.2020(Copy enclosed). I, **Sanyam Aggarwal, IAS, District Magistrate, Pathankot** in exercise of powers conferred upon me under section 144 of CrPC 1973 and National Disaster Management Act, 2005 order for the period 21.09.2020 to 30.09.2020 following activities will be permitted in District Pathankot :-

- (1) On-line distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged, Schools, Colleges, Educational and coaching institutions will, however, continue to remain closed for students and regular classes.
- (2) 50% of the teaching and non-teaching staff shall be allowed to be called to the schools at a time for on-line teaching/ tele-counselling and related work in areas outside the containment zones only as per SOP dated 08.09.2020(copy attached) issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India(GoI).
- (3) Higher Educational Institutions are allowed to open only for research Scholars (Ph.D) and post-graduate students of technical and professional programmers requiring laboratories/experimental works.
- (4) Open air theaters are permitted to open with social distancing and wearing of face masks/covers. However, Cinema Halls, Swimming pools, entertainment parks, theaters and similar places will remain closed.

Orders issued by this office vide letter no. MA/5234-5256 dated 01-09-2020 imposing additional restrictions would continue to be in operation.

Sub: Guidelines on Unlock 4 to be implemented from 21.09.2020 to 30.09.2020.

1. This is in continuation to this office letter No. SS/SCSH/2020/604 dated the 31st August 2020 vide which guidelines on Unlock 4.0 to be implemented from 01.09.2020 to 30.09.2020 were issued and letter No. SS/SCSH/2020/612 dated the 9th September 2020 vide which additional restrictions were imposed in urban areas of the State from 09.09.2020 to 30.09.2020. These guidelines were issued in pursuance of letter No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated the 29th August 2020 of MHA on Unlock-4.

2. The MHA Order dated the 29th August 2020 has permitted certain activities w.e.f. 21.09.2020. It has accordingly been decided that the following activities will be permitted w.e.f. 21.09.2020 to 30.09.2020 :-

- (1) On-line distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged. Schools, colleges, educational and coaching institutions will, however, continue to remain closed for students and regular classes.
- (2) 50% of the teaching and non-teaching staff shall be allowed to be called to the schools at a time for on-line teaching/tele-counselling and related work in areas outside the containment zones only as per SOP dated 03.09.2020 (copy attached) issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India (GoI).
- (3) Higher Educational Institutions are allowed to open only for research Scholars (Ph.D) and post-graduate students of technical and professional programmers requiring laboratories/experimental works.
- (3) Open air theatres are permitted to open with social distancing and wearing of face masks/covers. However, cinema Halls, Swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres and similar places will remain closed.
