Whereas Unlock-4 orders Under section 144 of Cr.PC was imposed by undersigned to prevent and contain spread of Corona Virus Covid-19 disease vide order no. 5234-5256/MA dated 01.09.2020 and additional restrictions were imposed in urban areas from vide order no. MA/5476-97 dated 09.09.2020 and 5570-5584 dated 22.09.2020 up to 30.09.2020.

Whereas no Additional Chief Secretary, Home, Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh has issued detailed guidelines for reopening of activities outside containment zones to be implemented from 01.10.2020 to 31.10.2020 vide their letter No. SS/ACSH/2020/671 Dated the 1st Day of October, 2020 in continuation to their previous orders.

Whereas now keeping in view the guidelines issued by Additional Chief Secretary, Home, Government of Punjab by Aforesaid letter, I Sanyam Aggarwal, IAS, hereby issues the following orders in territorial jurisdiction of District Pathankot under section 144 of Cr.PC of 1973 and Disaster Management Act, 2005, in continuation to previous orders.

"Guidelines on re-opening of more activities in areas outside Containment zones and to extend lockdown in Containment zones to be implemented from 01.10.2020 to 31.10.2020"

1. Lockdown limited to Containment Zones:

- i. Lockdown shall remain in force in the Containment Zones till 31st October 2020.
- ii. Containment Zones shall be demarcated by District Revenue Officer at micro level after taking into consideration the guidelines of the MoHFW with the objective of effectively breaking the chain of transmission. Strict containment measures shall be enforced in these Containment zones and only essential activities shall be allowed. There shall be strict perimeter control to ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services. In the Containment zones, there shall be intensive contact tracing, house to house surveillance, and other clinical interventions as required. Guidelines of MoHFW shall be effectively implemented for the above purpose.
- iii. These Containment zones will be notified on the website by the DIO NIC Pathankot and will share information with MoHFW.



2. Restrictions imposed vide order no. MA/5476-97 Dated 09/09/2020 are removed herewith

- i. No week-end / night curfew on account of COVID-19 w.e.f 01.10.2020
- ii. NO restriction on opening and closing days or timings of shops, Restaurants, Hotels, Liquor vends etc. outside Containment zones on account of Covid-19 w.e.f. 01.10.2020.
- iii. Social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political functions and other congregations are allowed w.e.f. 01.10.2020 with a ceiling of 100 persons outside containment zones only as per SOP already issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoFHW), Government of India in this regard.
- iv. Marriage and funeral related events shall also be permitted participation upto 100 persons.
- v. There shall be no restriction on passenger capacity of all type of vehicles including the buses provided the windows are kept open during travel and all passengers wear mask.

3. National Directives

National Directives for COVID-19 Management as specified in annexure1 to MHA order dated 30.09.2020 shall be followed throughout the District.

4. Movement of Persons with SOP's

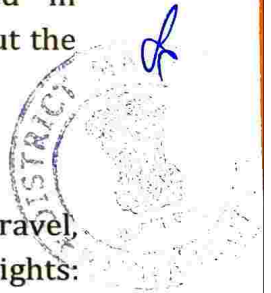
Movement by passenger trains: domestic passenger air travel, movement of persons on Vandhe Bharat and Air Transport, Bubble flights: and sign---on and sign-off of Indian seafarers will continue to be regulated as per SOPs issued.

5. Protection of vulnerable persons

The persons above 65 years of age, persons with co- morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years are advised to stay at home, except for essential requirement and health purposes.

6. Strict enforcement of the guidelines

As per para 9 of the MHA orders, the above mentioned guidelines and the norms of social distancing shall be strictly enforced under section 144 of the Criminal procedure code (Cr.PC) 1973.



7. Penal Provisions

Any violation of these guidelines and measures shall be punishable under Section 51-60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 beside legal action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC)

Strict compliance of above orders shall be ensured

This order shall come into force from 01.10.2020
