Therefore, keeping in view of sudden spike in Covid-19 cases in the district and to avoid the gathering of students in centres, all the IELTS/Coaching centres working in the district shall remain closed for offline classes till 30.04.2021. However, they are allowed to conduct online classes during this period.

Any violation of these guidelines shall be punishable under section 51 to 60 of Disaster management Act, 2005 besides legal action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC).
