Order

In view of surge of Covid-19 cases and keeping in view of latest guidelines received from the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh vide no. 7/56/2020/2H4/2069 dated 27.04.2021 (Copy Attached).

Now, I, Sanyam Aggarwal, IAS, District Magistrate Pathankot considering Covid-19 situation in the District Pathankot, all restrictions imposed vide this office order No. MA/3723 dated 20.04.2021 (copy attached) shall continue to be strictly enforced throughout the District w.e.f. 27th April, 2020 till further orders :-

- (i) All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 pm with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 pm.
- (ii) Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 pm to 5 am) shall now be from 6 pm to 5 am on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
- (iii) Week-end curfew from 5.00 am on Saturday upto 5 am on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.
- (iv) All private offices including service industry allowed to 'work from home' only.

The following activities shall, subject however to observance of covid appropriate behavior by all concerned, be exempted from Covid restrictions mentioned in para 2 above.

- (i) Chemist shops and shops dealing with supply of essential goods like milk, dairy products, vegetables, fruits etc.
- (ii) Manufacturing industry.
Movement of employees/labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them is allowed. However, concerned industry shall issue them requisite permission for the purpose.
- (iii) 'To and fro' movement of passengers travelling via air, trains, buses etc.
- (iv) Construction activities in both the Urban and rural areas.
- (v) Agricultural including procurement, horticultural, animal husbandry, veterinary services.
- (vi) E-commerce and movement of all goods.
- (vii) Vaccination out-reach camps.

The Police authority and Special duty Magistrates shall also continue to ensure strict implementation of all the extant directives of MHA/State Government on Covid appropriate behavior including social distancing norm of maintaining minimum 6 feet distance (2 Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places and public transport and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of Covid appropriate behavior like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc.

Sub: Additional restrictions regarding Covid applicable w.e.f. 27th April, 2021 till further orders.


1. In continuation to this office letter No. 7/56/2020/2H4/1968 dated the 19th April 2021 in the subject matter which shall be enforced till further orders.

2. In addition to the restrictions as imposed vide letter referred to hereinabove, the following additional restrictions shall be strictly and meticulously enforced throughout the State w.e.f. 27th April, 2020 till further orders:-

- (i) All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 pm with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 pm.
- (ii) Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 pm to 5 am) shall now be from 6 pm to 5 am on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
- (iii) Week-end curfew from 5.00 am on Saturday upto 5 am on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.


