



Order

In pursuance of the directions/order issued by the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana and Chairperson Stat Executive Committee, Haryana State Disaster Management Authority, Chandigarh vide memo no. DMC-SPO-2020/5761 dated 23.05.2021 and in exercise the powers conferred upon me under the Section 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, **I, Dr. Aditya Dahiya, I.A.S., District Magistrate-cum-District Disaster Management Authority, Jind**, do hereby extend the **Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana "महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा"** for another one week i.e. from 24.05.2021 (05:00 AM onwards) to 31.05.2021 (till 05:00 AM) in District, Jind alongwith guidelines to be implemented (during the period) issued vide orders No. No. 3012-3040/MA dated 03.05.202, No.3237-3300/MA dated 10.05.2021 & 3571-3596 dated 16.05.2021. **However, some relaxations are hereby provided with immediate effect, as mentioned below:-**

1. Stand alone shops are allowed to open during the day when the night curfew is not in operation.
2. Shops other than stand alone shops are allowed to open from 07:00 AM to 12 Noon in two groups namely odd and even- shops with odd numbers on odd dates and shop with even numbers on even dates. Malls are not allowed to open.

District Municipal Commissioner, Jind will ensure that the municipalities will publicize the guidelines/orders amongst the shopkeepers. The odd-even numbers will be identified/ marked by respective Urban Local Bodies and also ensure that shops should be opened in two groups namely odd and even-shops will odd numbers on odd dates and shops with even numbers on even dates as per the order issued by the Govt. of Haryana. The same will be done in rural areas by the District Development & Panchayat Officer, Jind.

Concerned Sub Divisional Magistrate will be overall incharge in their respective jurisdiction to keep the regular surveillance of every activity and will ensure strict enforcement of this order.

Superintendent of Police, Jind shall constitute inspection Teams for regular vigilance for implementation of this order.

Any person violating these lockdown measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, beside legal action under Sec. 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.
