



## Order

In pursuance of the directions/order issued by the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana and Chairperson Stat Executive Committee, Haryana State Disaster Management Authority, Chandigarh vide memo no. DMC-SPO-2020/7199 dated 04.07.2021 and in exercise the powers conferred upon me under the Section 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, **I, Dr. Aditya Dahiya, I.A.S., District Magistrate-cum-District Disaster Management Authority, Jind**, do hereby extend the **Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana** “महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा” for another one week i.e. from 05.07.2021 (05:00 AM onwards) to 12.07.2021 (till 05:00 AM) in District, Jind alongwith guidelines to be implemented (during the period) issued vide orders No.3012-3040/MA dated 03.05.2021, No.3237-3300/MA dated 10.05.2021., 3571-3596 dated 16.05.2021., No. 3763-3788/MA dated 23.05.2021., No. 3941-3965/MA dated 30.05.2021. No. 4101-4124/MA dated 06.06.2021. No. 4188-413/MA dated 14.06.2021. No. 4356-4379/MA dated 20.06.2021. and No. 4475-4499/MA dated 27.06.2021.

**The Institute of Chartered Accountants allowed to hold “ chartered accountant examinations” from 5th July 2021 to 20th July 2021. While conducting the some “guidelines for examination centers, examination functionaries and candidates for July 2021 CA examination in wake of ongoing pandemic covid-19”( Annexure ‘A’) released by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India along with “Revised SOP issues by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare dated 10-09-2020 recording preventive measures to be followed to contain spread of COVID-19” (Annexure ‘B’) Shall be strictly followed.**

**It has also been decided to allow the Common Entrance Exam (CEE) to be held at Hisar by the army Recruiting officer, military station Hisar subject to strict observation of social Distancing norms, sanitation and COVID appropriate behavioural norms.**

**However, some relaxations are hereby provided in modification of earlier order issued vide No. 4475-4499/MA dated 27.06.2021, as mentioned below:-**

- a. All shops are allowed to open from 09:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- b. Malls are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 08:00 PM.
- c. Restaurants and bars (including in hotels and in malls) are allowed to open from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with 50% of the seating capacity and adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms. Home delivery from hotels, restaurants and fast food joints is permitted upto 10:00 PM.
- d. Religious places are allowed to open with 50 persons at one time with the condition that they follow requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.

- e. Corporate Offices are permitted to open with full attendance subject to strict observance of social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms.
- f. Gatherings in weddings, Funerals/Cremations are allowed upto 50 persons subject to strict observance of COVID-19 appropriate behavioural norms and social distancing. However, weddings can take place at places other than home and Courts also. No movement of 'Barat' procession will be allowed.
- g. In open spaces, gatherings will be allowed with ceiling of 50 persons subject to strict observance of COVID-19 appropriate behavioural norms and social distancing.
- h. Club houses/ restaurants/ bars of the Golf Courses are allowed to open with 50% seating capacity from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with adherence to requisite social distancing and other COVID-19 appropriate safety norms. Members/visitors shall be allowed to play in Golf Courses by the management in a staggered manner so as to avoid overcrowding.
- i. Gyms are allowed to open from 06:00 AM to 08:00 PM with 50% capacity after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- j. All production units, establishments, Industries are permitted to function. However they shall strictly adhere to Covid appropriate and prescribed guidelines, behavioural norms and social distancing.
- k. Sports Complexes, Stadia are permitted to open for sports activities including for outdoor sports activities except contact sports (spectators will not be allowed). District Sports Officer, Kaithal shall ensure adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation of the premises and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- l. Swimming Pools and Spas shall remain closed.
- m. University Campus are allowed to open for Research Scholars, practical classes in laboratories and remedial classes/doubt classes by adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitization and covid-19 appropriate behavioral norms.

Concerned Sub Divisional Magistrate will be overall incharge in their respective jurisdiction to keep the regular surveillance of every activity and will ensure strict enforcement of this order.

Superintendent of Police, Jind shall constitute inspection Teams for regular vigilance for implementation of this order.

Any person violating these lockdown measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, beside legal action under Sec. 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.
