ORDER

(Haryana Government, Chief Secretary Office, Political & Parliamentary Affairs Department
Memo No. 41/14/2016-5Pol Dated 29-3-2020).

Whereas, in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 10(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, National Executive Committee, has issued as order of even number dated 24-3-2020 followed by Addendum orders of even number dated 25.03.2020 and 27.03.2020 to the Ministers/ Departments of Government of India, State/Union Territory Government and state/Union Territory Authorities with the directions of implement lockdown measures annexed to the said orders for the containment of spread of COVID-19 in the country.

Whereas, movement of a large number of migrants have taken place in some parts of the country so as to reach their home towns. This is a violation of the lockdown measures on maintaining social distance.

Whereas, to deal with situation ad for effective implementation of the lockdown measures, and to mitigate the economic hardship of the migrant workers, in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 10(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, National Executive Committee hereby directs the State/Union Territory Government and state/Union Territory Authorities to take necessary action and to issues necessary order ti their

1. State/Union Territory Government shall ensure adequate arrangements of temporary shelters, and provision of food etc. for the poort and needy people, including migrant labourers, Standard due to lockdown measures in their respective area.
2. The migrants people, who have moved out to reach their home states/home towns, must be kept in the respective state/Union Territory government quarantine facility after proper screening for a minimum period of 14 days as per standard health protocol.
3. All the employers, be it in the industry or in the shops and commercial establishments, shall make payment of wages of their workers, at their work places, on the due date, without any deduction, for the period their establishments are under closure during the lockdown.
4. Where ever the workers, including the migrants are living in rented accommodation, the landlords of those properties shall not demand payment of rent for a period of one month
5. Of any landlord is forcing laborers and student to vacate their premises they will be liable for action under the Act.

Superintendent of Police to direct all SHO's for strict implementation of the restrictions. However, the nCOVID-19 is a disaster for the country. Hence, the public in general are advised to inform the concerned SHO if any seen indulge to open shops to sale the items other than essential commodities.

Failure to obey these orders shall be penalized under section 188 of I.P.C. with punishment of severe fine and imprisonment In view of requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order, is being passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through the press and publicity van of public relations department and by affixing copy at notice board of District Courts, Zila Parishad, Sub Divisions, Tehsils, Municipal Council, Municipal Committees, Panchayat Samities, Police Stations and Public Places.
