## Country's largest Public Works Rest House

In the year-2017, Gurugram also got the largest Public Works Rest House of the State which was inaugurated by the Chief Minister. Public works Rest House of almost 100 rooms has been constructed at a cost of Rs. 35 crores. This Rest House is built on 4.7 acres of land. There is also a provision for Stay of the drivers and other staff also.



## Smart Village Scheme by the President

In the year 2017, the then President of India Pranab Mukherjee visited District Gurugram and adopted 100 villages under Smart Gram Scheme. Now facilities similar to cities will be available in these villages. In the first phase, 5 villages of Gurugram District were adopted by the President in which outstanding work in the areas of education, health, agriculture, skill development, electricity, drinking water, employment etc was done under Smart Gram and in view of unprecedented success in these five villages, the President has extended the number of villages from 5 to 100.

## **International Arbitration Center in the Tower of Justice**

The construction of a District Court pending since the previous government's tenure in Gurugram was also undertaken by the present government. Construction of the Tower of Justice began this year on 7 acres of Land, which will cost around Rs 180 crore. The International Arbitration Center will be built in this Tower of Justice. This center will provide a platform for resolving international settlement disputes.



## **Foundation Laying of largest butterfly conservatory**

The foundation of the largest butterfly conservatory of Northern India was laid in Gurugram. This conservatory will be developed on 15 acres of land in Sector 52 Gurugram. This park will be an exhibition of scientific knowledge about butterflies as well as a green area in the city of Gurugram. Another feature of this project is that for the first time in India, the Firefly section is also being set up in this park. In the conservatory, Information and Display Center, larva / pupa area, group area of favorable plants, green house for home reproduction, office and record room, nakshatra gardens, nursery zone, firefly protection zone, Restaurant etc. will be developed. Simultaneously, Haryana's Public Works Minister Rao Narbir Singh inaugurated the Agricultural Forestry Model Exhibition Center for the arid and semi-arid areas of Haryana in Mashadpur and laid the foundation stone of Late.Rao Mahabir Singh Herbal Park.

## **Inauguration of 50-bed civil hospital in Pataudi Sub-Division**

Chief Minister Manohar Lal inaugurated the 50-bed Civil Hospital in Pataudi Sub-Division of Gurugram District, on which an amount of about Rs. 9 crores has been spent.
