

Order Under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973

Whereas, the COVID-19 has been declared as pandemic by the World Health Organization and National Disaster Management Authority, being satisfied that the country is threatened with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Whereas, it is evident that there has been an exponential surge in the Covid cases in the District Gurugram, and necessary measures are to be adopted to contain the spread of the Covid-19 and also to ensure minimum collateral damage to the system.

The Government of Haryana has considered it necessary to take effective measures to prevent and contain the spread of the Covid-19 virus in the state of Haryana including district Gurugram in the interest of maintenance of public health, hygiene and safety.

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of Cr. Pc. 1973, **I, Yash Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, Gurugram**, do hereby prohibit the gathering of more than four people, unless specifically permitted.

This order shall not apply on police force and other public servants on duty, persons of medical industries/institutions, persons working in sectors related to essential products / services.

This order shall come in to force with effect from 25-04-2021.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code. Commissioner of Police, Gurugram shall implement this order.

It shall be published for the information of public in general through the press and publicity Van of public relations department and by affixing copies at notice board of all Offices of the district administration, Commissioner of Police, District Court, Deputy Commissioner, Commissioner Municipal Corporation, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Tehsil, Zila Parishad, Panchayat Samiti, All Police Station and other prominent places.
