Order

Whereas, the COVID-19 has been declared as pandemic by the world health organisation and National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) being satisfied that the whole country including the state of Haryana is threatened with covid-19 pandemic.

Whereas, it is evident that there has been an exponential surge in the COVID cases in the District Gurugram and necessary measures are to be ensured by district administration to contain the spread of covid-19 and also to ensure minimum collateral damage to the system.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of the District Administration that Government/ Private Hospitals are facing acute shortage of liquid oxygen for the treatment of COVID-19 patients. So it becomes necessary to ensure a continuous and smooth supply of sufficient quantity of liquid oxygen to the concerned hospitals.

Vide order no. 40-6/2020-DM-I(A) dated 25.04.2021, the Union Home Secretary/Chairman, National Executive Committee, National Disaster Management Authority in exercise of powers conferred to him under section-10(2)(i) and section 65 of the Disaster Management Act has directed all state Governments to ensure that use of liquid oxygen is not allowed for any non-medical purpose and that all manufacturing units may maximize their production of liquid oxygen, and make it available to the Government for use for medical purposes only. It has been further directed that all stocks of liquid oxygen, should also be made available to the Government for use for medical purposes and no exception may be allowed to any industry with regard to use of liquid oxygen.

Whereas, in compliance of Union Home Secretary/Chairman, National Executive Committee, National Disaster Management Authority order no. 40-6/2020-DM-I(A) dated 25.04.2021 and in exercise of powers conferred under movable and immovable property act 1973 (25 of 1973) & in exercise of powers under relevant provisions of the National Disaster Management Act, 2005, I, **Yash Garg, IAS, Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Gurugram** do hereby requisite all stocks and supply of liquid oxygen and such appropriate cylinders of Swimming Pools in the whole Gurugram District.
