

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973**

Whereas, It has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension, annoyance, obstruction or injury to persons, danger to human life and property, disturbance of public peace and law & order within the limits of examination centres on account of Written Examination HCS (Ex. Br.) & other Allied Services Preliminary Examination-2021 on 12.09.2021 in two sessions i.e. 10.00 AM to 12.00 Noon and 03.00 PM to 05.00 PM in various educational institutions of Gurugram District being conducted by the Haryana Public Services Commission, Panchkula.

Whereas, It has been made to appear to me that the gathering of four or more persons, carrying any weapon like Fire Arms, Swords, Barchhas, Kulharis, Jellies, Bhallas, Knives, Lathis, Cycle Chain and other weapons of offence or any other thing which is capable of being used as weapon of offence or is likely to cause obstruction in the maintenance of peace and law & order and it has become necessary to prohibit the carrying of weapons of offence within the area of about 100 meters around the examination centres in District Gurugram.

And whereas, I, am satisfied that directions are necessary to avoid injury to persons lawfully employed or risk or danger to human life and property and disturbance to the public tranquillity or riot or affray.

Now therefore, **I, Dr. Yash Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, Gurugram** in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of the code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 do hereby prohibit the gathering of four or more persons carrying any weapons of offence like Fire Arms, Swords, Barchhas, Kulharis, Jellies, Bhallas, Knives, Lathis, Cycle Chain and other weapons in the premises of Schools/colleges/institutions and in the area of 100 meters around the examination centres in Gurugram District on 12.09.2021 till examination is over. Further, all the Photostat machine shops and coaching centres situated within the jurisdiction of District Gurugram will remain closed from 09.00 AM to 06.00 PM on 12.09.2021. The candidate should not carry any mobile phone, pager, electronic or communication device etc. in the premises/boundary wall of the examination centre.

This order shall not apply to the Examinee, Police and other public servants on duty.

In view of the emergent situation and shortage of time, this order is being passed ex-parte and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated within the limits of Gurugram District through publicity van of public relations department as also by affixing of copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional & Tehsils, Courts, Public places as well as the Police Stations.

Commissioner of Police, Gurugram shall be responsible for the compliance of the above orders. Any person found guilty of violation of this order shall be prosecuted and punished as per law under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
