

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, it has been intimated by Deputy Commissioner of Police (HQ), Gurugram vide his office letter No. 8921/Sec dated 15-09-2021 that Hon'ble Vice President of India is visiting at Gurugram on 19-09-2021. There is an apprehension that some anti social elements etc may try to hold strike/ demonstration during this function. Therefore, keeping in view of the above and in order to contain the unflux of such anti-social elements, it is requested that an order under section 144 Cr. P.C. may kindly be promulgated making it mandatory for public/workers not to hold any kind of demonstration near the place of function and not to operate any kind of flying object like drone, paraglide etc near place of function i.e. Auditorium, Apparel House, Sector-44, Gurugram, Northcap University, Sector-23, Gurugram and PWD Rest House, Gurugram.

And whereas, I, am satisfied that directions are necessary to avoid injury to persons lawfully employed or risk or danger to human life and property and disturbance to the public tranquility or riot or affray.

Now therefore, **I, Dr. Yash Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, Gurugram** in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of the code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 do hereby direct that it is mandatory for public/workers not to hold any kind of demonstration near the place of function and not to operate any kind of flying object like drone, paraglide etc near place of function i.e. Auditorium, Apparel House, Sector-44, Gurugram, Northcap University, Sector-23, Gurugram and PWD Rest House, Gurugram.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 17-09-2021 and shall remain in enforce upto 19-09-2021.

In view of the emergent situation and shortage of time, this order is being passed ex-parte and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated within the limits of Gurugram District through publicity van of public relations department as also by affixing of copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional & Tehsils, Courts, Public places, Schools, Markets as well as the Police Stations.

Commissioner of Police, Gurugram shall be responsible for the compliance of the above orders. Any person found guilty of violation of this order shall be prosecuted and punished as per law under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
