

**ORDER UNDER SECTION SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL
PROCEDURE, 1973**

Whereas, it has been intimated by Chairperson Haryana State Executive Committee (under State Disaster Management Authority) vide Memo No. DMC-SPO-2020/11885 31-10-2021 that amidst the covid-19 pandemic through which the State of Haryana is passing and considering the approaching winter season during which the elderly children, persons with co-morbidities and others, may develop respiratory problems. During the approaching festival season of Diwali, Gurupurab and Kartik Purnima, Christmas eve, New Year eve, people usually bursts crackers which can adversely affect the respiratory health of vulnerable groups, besides, aggravating health condition of Covid-19 positive persons staying in home isolation. Accordingly, in compliance of the various directions of NGT and Hon'ble Supreme Court there will be a total ban against sale or use of all kind of fire crackers in all the 14 NCR districts.

As whereas I am satisfied that such order is necessary Keeping in view the safety of people due to emergent pollution in the district .

Now, therefore in exercise of powers vested in me by virtue of u/s 144 CrPC 1973, I, Dr. Yash Garg, I.A.S, District Magistrate, Gurugram do hereby order that there will be a total ban against sale or use of all kind of fire crackers in District Gurugram during the festival season of Diwali, Gurupurab and Kartik Purnima, Christmas eve, New Year eve.

In view of requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order is being passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through the press and publicity van of the public relation department by publication in local Newspapers, by fixation of copies of order on Notice Board in District Court, Tehsils, Public and Police Stations.

This order shall come in to force with immediate effect.

Commissioner of Police, Gurugram shall be responsible for the compliance of the above orders. Any person found guilty of violation of this order shall be prosecuted and punished as per law under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

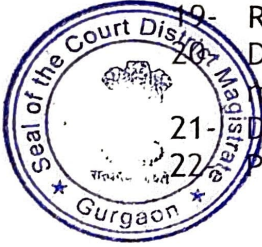
